SUPERVISOR DOCKBUILDER

General Statement of Duties and Responsibilities

Under general direction, supervises the work of a group of dockbuilders and other workers involved in the construction, maintenance and repair of waterfront structures; performs related work.

Examples of Typical Tasks

Assigns, directs and inspects the work of dockbuilders, pile driver crews and derrick crews in the construction, maintenance and repair of wharves, ferry racks, piers, docks (both timber and concrete), bulkheads, platforms and other waterfront structures.

Supervises operations involved in pile driving, shoring, demolition, dredging and associated activities.

Enforces safety precautions at work sites to safeguard life and property.

Requisitions materials and equipment.

Keeps records and makes reports.

Qualification Requirements

One (1) year of permanent service in the title of Dockbuilder.

Note:

This title is classified in the non-competitive class for a 12-month period under the New York Hiring Emergency Limited Placement Statewide Program – Local (NY HELPS Program). At the conclusion of 12 months incumbents will be transferred into "Supervisor Dockbuilder (92072)" as competitive class employees.

Probationary Period:

This title is subject to a 12-month probationary period. The period of probation may be served while in the non-competitive classification under the NY HELPS Program or in the competitive classification, or both. However, all employees must serve a total of 12 months of probation.
