Duties Statement

The Chief Information Officer supports the Commissioner and the First Deputy Commissioner by planning and determining priorities for all information systems and development activities for the Department of Design and Construction. The Chief Information Officer will manage all Technology & Innovation units within the agency, which provide essential support and applications to advance the Agency's policy agenda as well as its legally mandated activities and leverage the power of technology to improve service delivery, drive innovation, automate business processes, and reduce operating costs. The Chief Information Officer will be responsible for the entirety of the agency's technology projects, programs, databases, and initiatives. Additionally, the Chief Information Officer will be responsible for the agency's cyber-security efforts and risk reduction to agency security.
