RESOLVED, that the Personnel Rules and Regulations of the City of New York are hereby amended as follows:

ADD:

6.2.8 Reinstatement of Employees Dismissed for Noncompliance with the COVID-19 Vaccination Mandate

- (a) Notwithstanding any other rule or regulation, upon written application for reinstatement by a person who was dismissed from a permanent competitive or labor class position due to noncompliance with the COVID-19 vaccination mandate, an agency may, in its discretion and with the approval of the commissioner of citywide administrative services, reinstate such person, provided that:
 - 1. Such application is submitted within 30 calendar days of the effective date of this rule; and
 - 2. Such reinstatement may be subject to such investigation, medical examination, or other qualifying requirements applicable to the position as the commissioner of citywide administrative services shall determine.
- (b) This section shall expire and be deemed repealed on December 31, 2027.
