



**CITY CANVAS**

**PRE-APPROVED ARTWORK  
LICENSING AND FEE GUIDELINES**

Thank you for your interest in the City Canvas program. These license and fee guidelines are meant to guide property owners who wish to license Pre-Approved Artwork for their temporary protective structures. The Department of Cultural Affairs (DCLA) is not responsible for contracting between property owners and artists but will liaise an introduction.

Each Pre-Approved Artwork includes a suite of three components designed for each type of temporary protective structure: construction sheds, fences, and scaffolding. Each component can be used discretely or in ensembles. DCLA proposes a tiered fee structure for the use of each additional component of a Pre-Approved Artwork being licensed. These fees were determined through insights gained during the City Canvas pilot period and industry references. This recommendation is not compulsory and is meant to serve as a point of departure for artists and property owners who will negotiate independently of DCLA.
