Community Improvements

This project will improve safety and circulation at this heavily used transit hub by permanently incorporating the temporary pedestrian safety improvements installed in 2018 through full reconstruction of Parsons Blvd from Archer to Jamaica Avenues.

- The scope of the project includes expanded and enhanced pedestrian space, installation of curb extensions at key intersections, and dedicated locations for commuter van pickup.

DURING CONSTRUCTION

Working Hours During Construction



Work hours on this project will vary by location. Typical work hours are:

- Work Hours: Monday - Friday; 7:00am-3:30pm
- Construction Shift: Eight (8) Hours
- The contractor will follow all DOT – OCMC Allowable Hours, as per OCMC stipulated issued street permits.
- The contractor will follow all DOT & Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO) events and embargos.

Traffic Patterns During Construction



Contractors will maintain the following:

- Provide professional rodent control inspector to monitor/maintain Rodent Control Station.
- Personnel, signage, and safe work site for pedestrians and vehicles
- Pedestrian access to buildings and sidewalks; notify bikers of work ahead
- Keep a minimum width of 5' access on sidewalks and crosswalks
- Maintain travel lanes; temporary reduction of travel lanes may be necessary
- Full roadway closure – intermittent and when necessary



IMPACTS

COMMUNITY IMPACTS & MITIGATIONS

Contractor shall:

- Obtain Pre-Construction Reports (which will be done by a separate entity).
- Work within DEP Noise Code Regulations.
- Post advance Contractor's 24-hour notice to impacted area.
- Keep storage site and MPT area clean & safe.
- Cover trucks delivering fill material.

COMMUNITY IMPACTS & MITIGATIONS (cont'd)

- Parking may be temporarily restricted when necessary; signs to be posted in advance.
- Garbage pick-up may be affected and will be coordinated with appropriate stakeholders.
- Individuals with special needs should contact the Resident Engineer. DDC field staff will work to minimize inconvenience.

Reconstruction of 8th Avenue & Grand Central Station Area (NYC Design & Construction)

The New York City Department of Design and Construction (NYC DDC) manages the reconstruction of the 8th Avenue Grand Central Station area in the Midtown East section of Manhattan. This reconstruction will include tree planting, Plaza reconstruction and Cobblestone, new Roadways, Curb, and Sidewalk. Due to sidewalk section and field conditions, this project is subject to change. The project has an anticipated completion date of Spring 2022.

Street and at the 8th Avenue Grand Central Station Area
The Contractor will then proceed to work on the installation of the remaining Street Lights and Traffic Signal South of West 23rd Street along 8th Avenue. Work will also commence at the intersection of 8th Avenue and West 23rd Street where the Contractor will install new traffic signals.

Special Needs
Individuals with special needs who may be uniquely impacted by this project should contact the project's Community Construction Liaison as soon as possible, to make them aware of your situation. CDC will work with you to minimize the inconvenience as much as possible.

Tree Relocation
Please place your trash properly to avoid any damage and/or spillage. Please put it in the designated areas as close to the collection time as possible. If you use a private carrier, ensure your trash collection occurs on a timely fashion. If you are not sure where to place your trash, please call the Community Construction Liaison (CCL).

During Construction
During construction hours, you can expect an increased level of dust, noise, and heavy equipment. Mitigation measures will be required, as well as stream. Warning signs will be posted in advance. Parking and driving/leading dogs restrictions, signage will be posted within the affected areas. Emergency vehicle access and pedestrian access to sidewalks and buildings will always be maintained.

Work Complete Plan Queue Item
At the southeast corner of 8th Avenue & West 23rd Street, the Contractor has completed the installation of the sub-construction facilities, installation of granite curb, sidewalk, concrete road base, and traffic signals. The Contractor completed the reconstruction of the Con Edison electrical facility at the southeast corner of 8th Avenue and West 23rd Street. The Contractor continues working on the Con Edison water facility at the intersection of 8th Avenue and West 23rd Street. The Contractor continued the installation of the Con Edison substation along 8th Avenue from West 23rd Street to West 22nd Street. The Contractor commenced and completed the installation of the traffic signal at the SE of Columbus street as a pedestrian crosswalk will be installed to allow pedestrian access to the plaza. The Contractor commenced the installation of a Con Edison electrical facility on West 23rd Street West of 8th Avenue. The Contractor commenced reconstruction of a Con Edison electrical facility at the southeast corner of 8th Avenue & West 23rd St. The Contractor commenced the installation of a Con Edison gas facility and DEP water main at the southeast corner of 8th Avenue & West 23rd Street.
