## **BENEFITS OF THIS PROJECT**

### **Scheduled Work Hours:**

7am to 6pm, Mon-Fri: Noisy Work Operations.

9pm to 5am,Mon-Fri: Pipe installations & any necessary temporary water shutdowns.

Contractor will follow all DOT & Street Activity Permit Office event embargos.



## **Traffic Patterns During Construction**

### Contractors shall maintain the following:

- Personnel, signage, and safe work site for pedestrians and vehicles.
- Maintain pedestrian access to sidewalks and crosswalks.
- Roadway Traffic will be maintained during and after construction.
- Driveway access may be temporarily restricted during work hours; but coordination is done case-by-case.
- Parking may be restricted when necessary; signs will be posted in advance.



## **Community Impacts and Mitigations**

<u>Public Transportation:</u> Bus stops may be relocated during the course of the project

<u>Rodent Control:</u> Rodent Control Stations will be installed by a professional rodent control contractor
