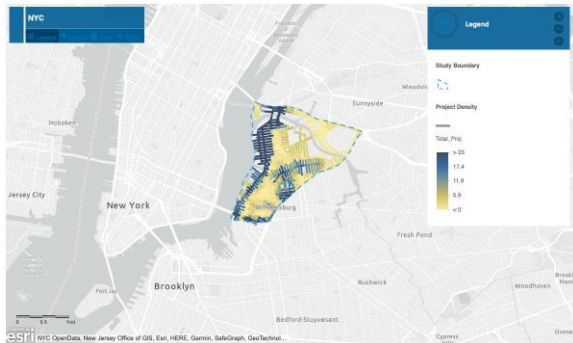


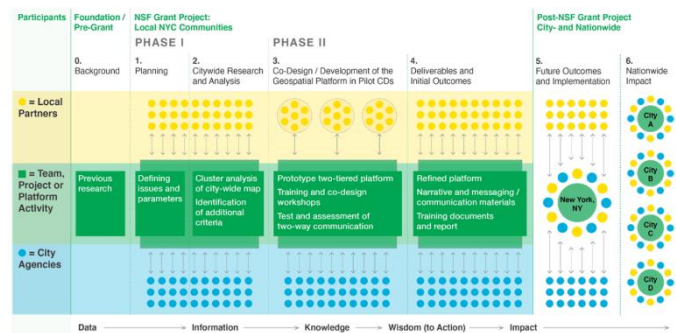
Optimizing Local Infrastructure and Community Resiliency Resilient People Places and Projects.3 November 3, 2022
