RESOLVED That the Design Commission, having considered designs for the installation of distinctive lighting, as part of the master plan for the Metropolitan Park (Queens Future), Roosevelt Avenue, between Grand Central Parkway and Seaver Way, and between the MTA New York City Transit Corona Maintenance Yard and the Whiteston, submitted by the Economic Development Corporation and the Department of Parks & Recreation, represented by exhibits 7786-R, S, T, U, V, W, X, Y & Z of record in this matter, hereby gives to the same unanimous preliminary approval with the understanding that the team will (1) continue to study the lighting hierarchy of Metropolitan Park as it relates to Citi Field Stadium and the Integrated Resort; (2) create operational guidelines that (a) do not permit flashing or strobing, (b) only permit subtle color change on event days, (c) limit programming to only three locations; at the Northfield Garage threshold, and underneath the north and south gateway bridges; (3) clarify the event-specific program of the Shea Lawn temporary structure; and (4) in advance of proceeding with a final review, provide an interim submission with a lighting impact study for the future Willets Point residences. Commissioner Castilla recused herself.

RESOLVED That the Design Commission, having considered designs for the construction of a skate garden, Mount Prospect Park, Eastern Parkway and Flatbush Avenue, Brooklyn, submitted by the Department of Parks and Recreation and the Economic Development Corporation, represented by exhibits 5359-D, E, F & G of record in this matter, hereby gives to the same unanimous preliminary approval with the understanding that the team will (1) in an interim submission before returning for final review, (a) submit design studies presenting alternative site plan layouts that maximize passive recreation space and maintain existing lawn uses, including an option to shift the placement of the skate garden elements to the west and (b) identify potential impacts resulting from these changes, including any elements that would be considered as losses, such as tree removals; (2) consider implementing bioswales at the planted edges; and (3) incorporate a visual cue to the park path, such as signage, or any safety measures, to discourage skateboarders from traveling downhill to Eastern Parkway.
