RESOLVED That the Design Commission, having considered designs for the reconstruction of a portion of John Allen Payne Playground, including the construction of a skate park, Third Avenue between 64th Street and 65th Street, Brooklyn, submitted by the Department of Parks & Recreation, represented by exhibits 2501-J, K, L & M of record in this matter, hereby gives to the same unanimous preliminary approval with the understanding that the team will (1) provide drawings showing the relationship between 64th Street, the perimeter chain link fence, and the triangular wall hip skate ramp, including section drawings and a perspective drawing that depicts the rear of the hip ramp, as viewed from 64th Street; (2) consider adding shock-absorbent wraps around the column bases for enhanced user safety; (3) consider (a) replacing sections of chain link fence with a different type of fence to minimize the confining visual impact, while still addressing operational needs, and (b) adding creative details to the 6'H chain link fence that separates the skatepark from the park's central path; (4)(a) clarify what the national lighting standard is for skatepark facilities and (b) whether the light intensity and/or illuminance levels need to be increased within the skatepark area, especially for use after sunset; and (5) consider specifying different tree species that are more resilient, especially with those that can tolerate a wide range of soil pH levels.
