

Consequently, approval is given with the understanding that the Parks Department will continue to (1) monitor the installation of the high friction coefficient recycled plastic lumber, and report back to the Commission on its findings; (2) continue to work with manufacturers to increase recycled plastic lumber's friction coefficient and develop alternative sustainable materials; (3) continue to pursue Black Locust, including exploring setting up its own Black Locust farm; (4) narrow the concrete lane to 10' (from 12'); (5) study moving the concrete lane inboard, and submit an alternative design(s) for committee review; and (6) test potential wood alternatives on this section of the boardwalk.
