



RESOLVED That the Design Commission, having considered designs for the reconstruction of Pier A Plaza, Battery Place and West Street, adjacent to Battery Park, Manhattan, submitted by the Economic Development Corporation, represented by exhibits 5690-Q, R & S of record in this matter, hereby gives to the same unanimous preliminary approval with the understanding that the design team will (1) clarify how “walkable area” in the Department of City Planning’s Waterfront Design Guidelines applies to a plaza; (2) provide photometrics for the plaza; (3) reduce the number of waterfront signs to two, square off the tops, and incorporate the no-smoking regulations as well as comprehensive rules; (4) eliminate the paver regulatory signs; (5) evaluate the conflict between the proposed signs and the existing water taxi signs and any Battery Park signs (approved June 27, 2011); (6) specify the simplified tube reflector for the post and chain; (7) specify an alternate material for the bench slats, in case black locust is difficult to acquire; (8) clarify whether the bolt holes on the flagpole bases will be flush or capped; (9) consider a lead seal or a cap that fits over the top of the flagpole bases, as sealant will have to be maintained; (10) provide a detail of how the flagpole bases will meet the granite planter; and (11) revise the text of the historic signs.
