Dear Mr. Walcott,

Congratulations on your appointment as the Chair of the New York City Redistricting Commission. I wish you immense success in this role.

I write as the Executive Director of the Jewish Community Council of Greater Coney Island, Inc., a nonprofit organization that has served Southern Brooklyn communities for more than thirty years.

It is my belief that the community of Brighton Beach, often referred to as Greater Coney Island, should be in one unified City Council district, as it was prior to the 2012 redistricting. Currently, neighboring high-rise buildings including Trump Village, Luna Park, and Brightwater Towers are in the 48th Council District, while Warbasse, located just steps away, is in the 47th Council District.

Coney Island, Sea Gate, and Brighton Beach (including Trump Village, Warbasse, Luna Park, and Brightwater Towers) are currently parts of the same Community Board (13), police precinct (60th), Assembly District (46th), State Senate District (23rd), and Congressional District (8th). These communities share similar issues, concerns, interests, and demographics. Significantly, the boardwalk and beach, which borders Brighton Beach and Coney Island, is a part of the 47th Council District, and of major community significance to Brighton Beach.

I thank you for your consideration of this perspective.
