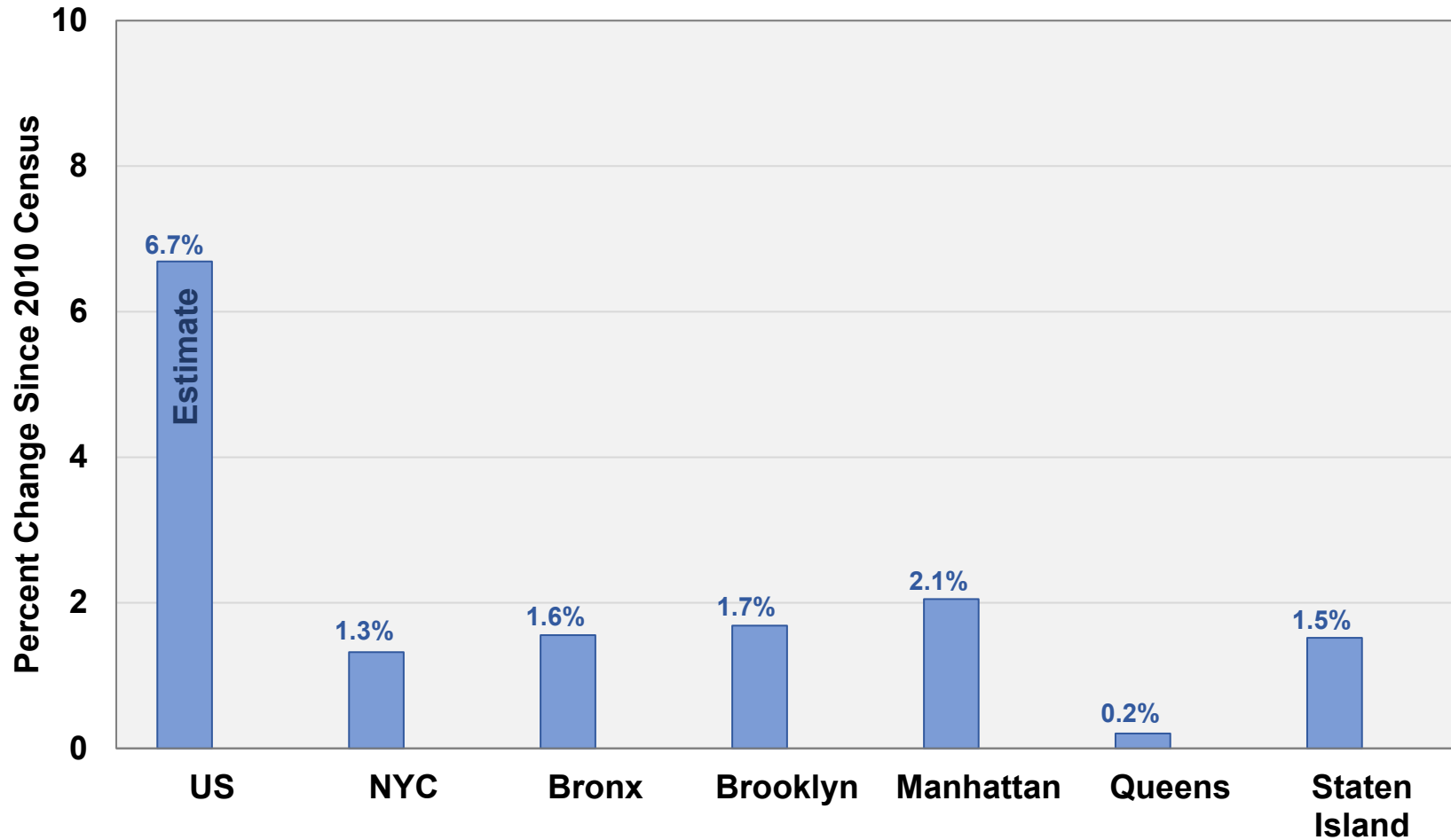

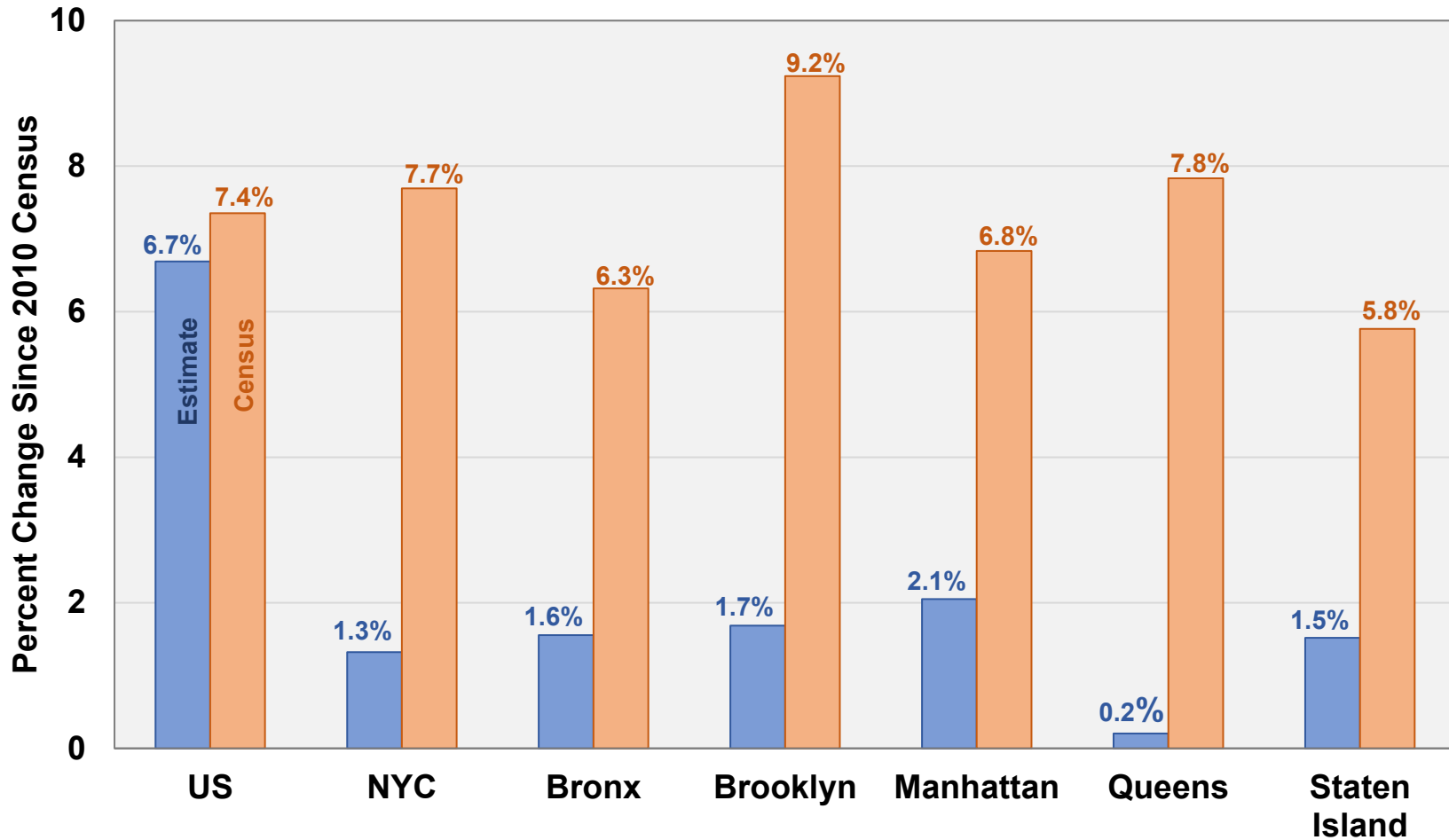

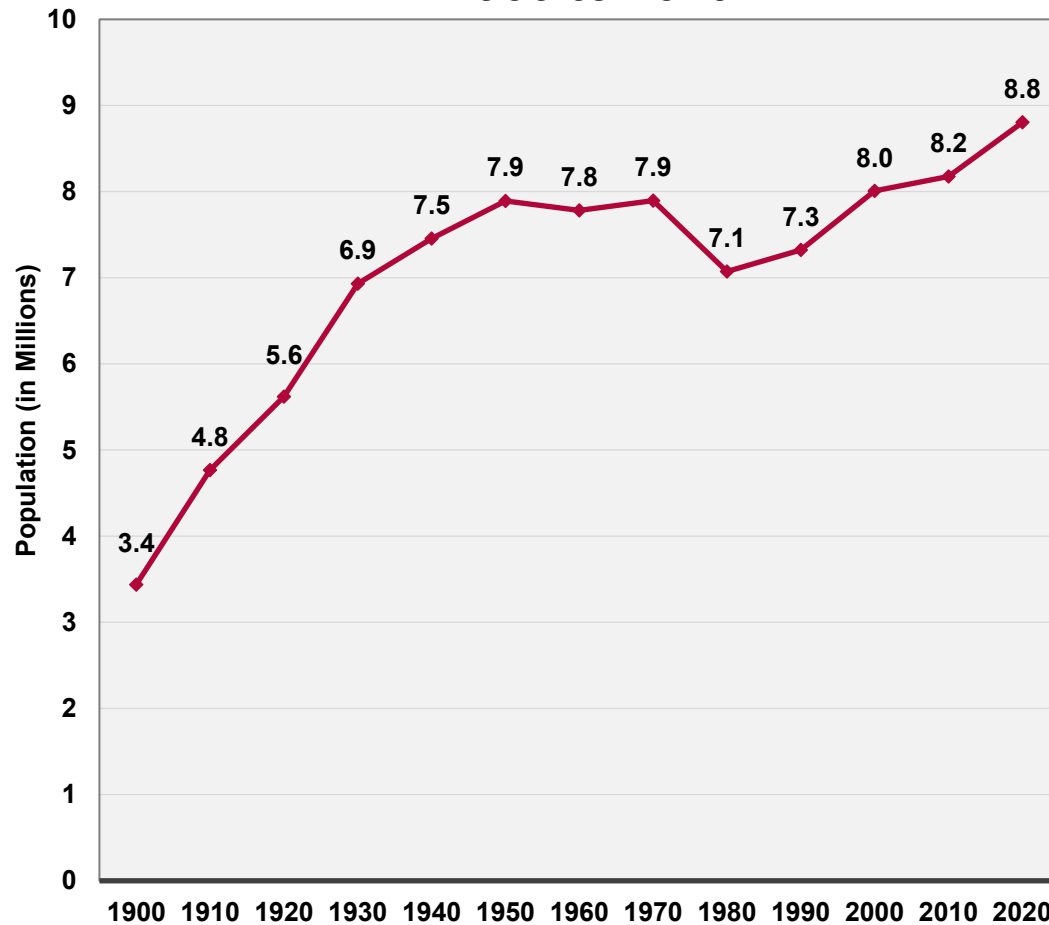

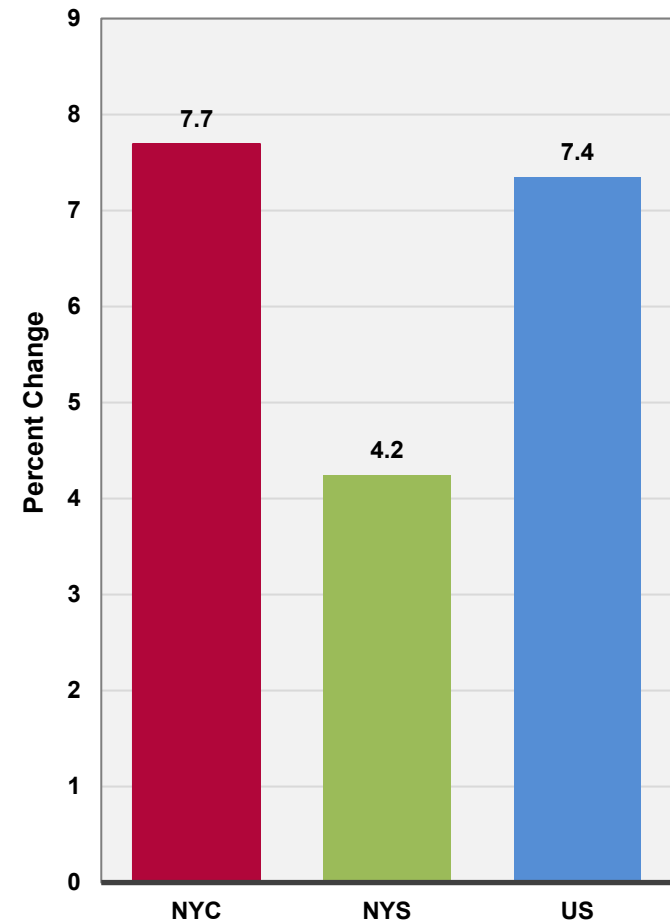
Total and Percent Change in Population NYC, New York State, and US, 1900-2020



Total Population, NYC 1900 to 2020



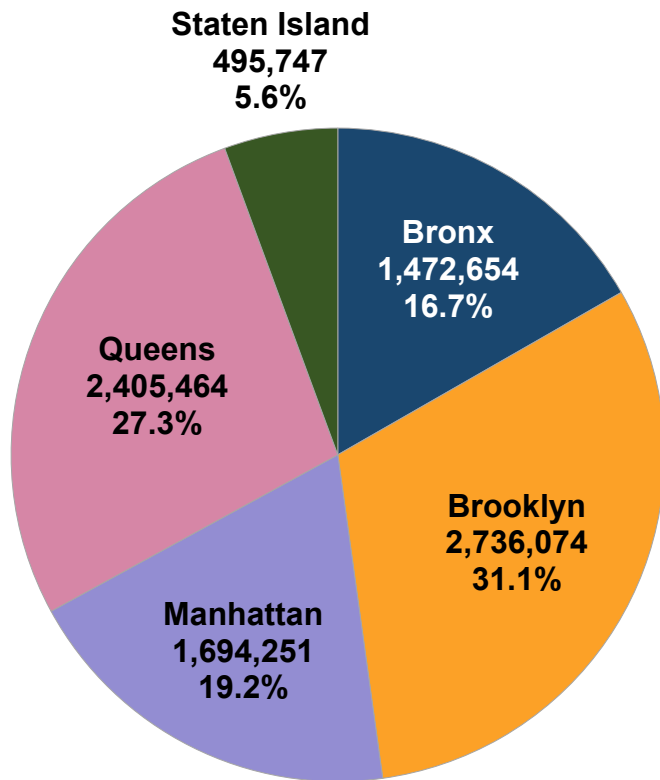
Percent Change, 2010 to 2020



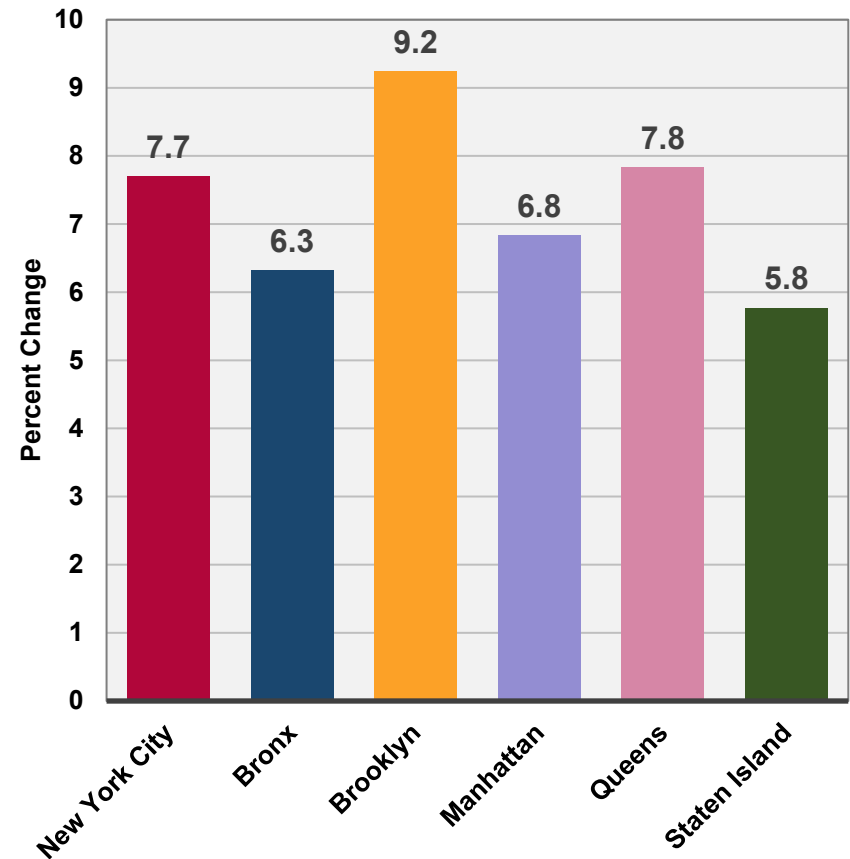
Population Distribution by Borough & Percent Change New York City & Boroughs, 2010-2020

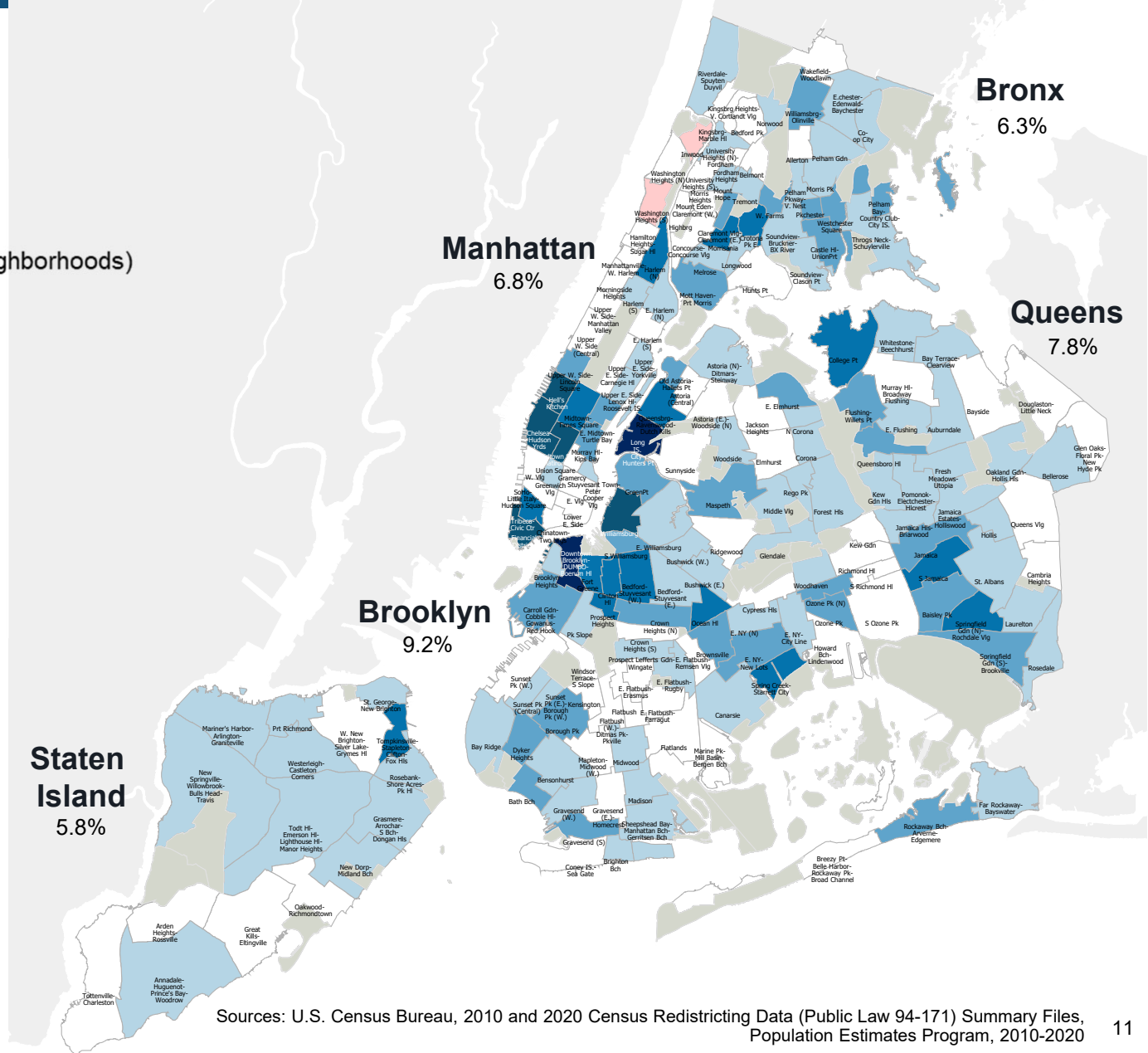
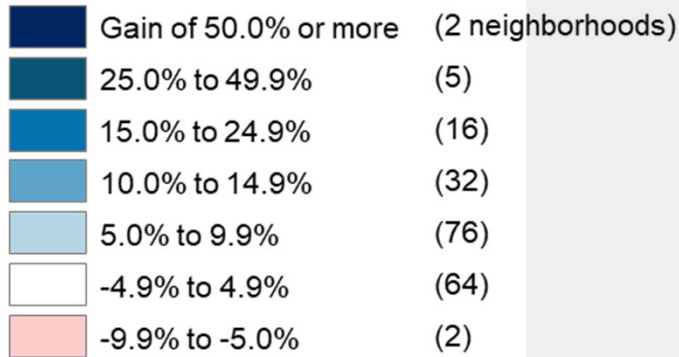

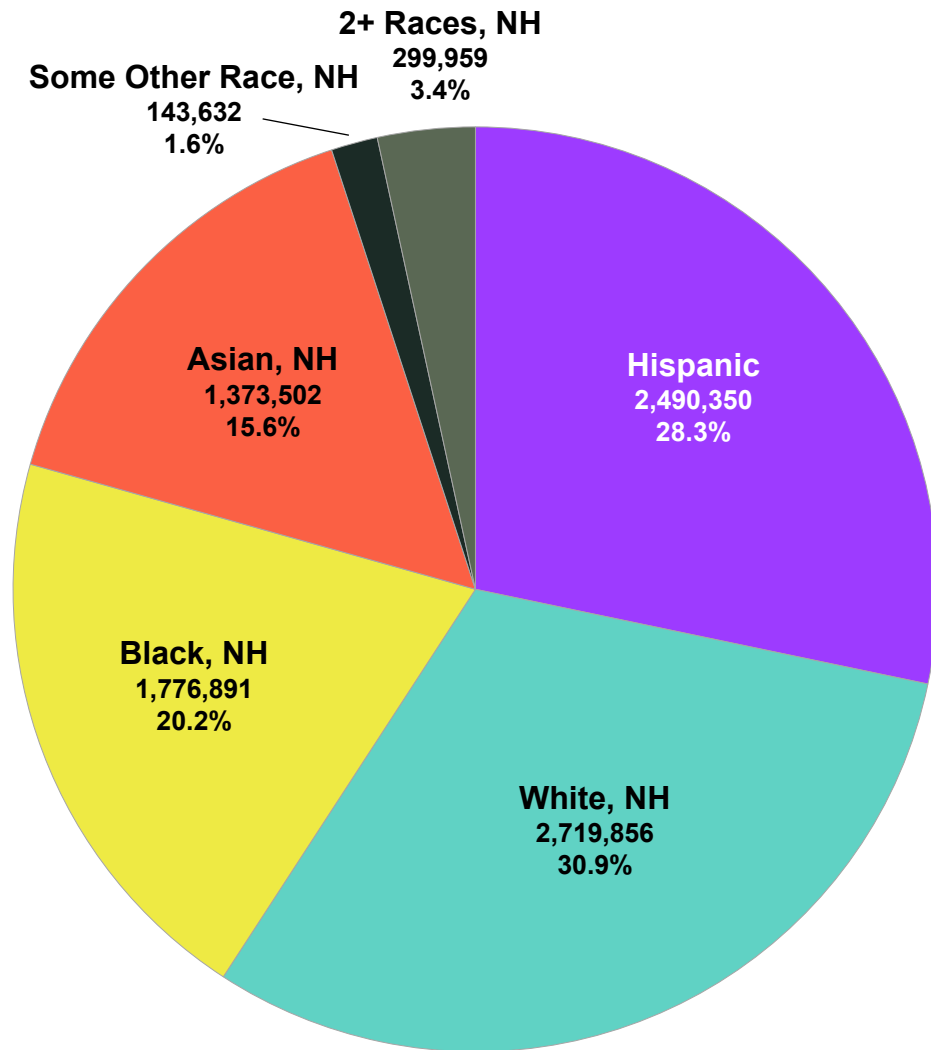

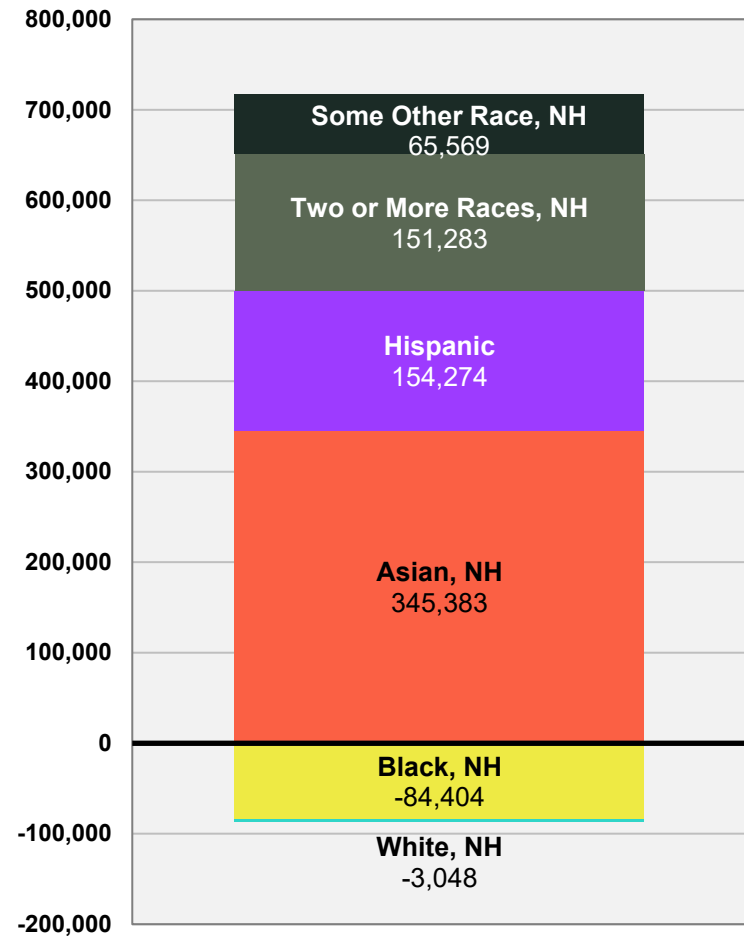
Population Distribution by Race and Hispanic Origin New York City, 2020 & Change 2010-2020

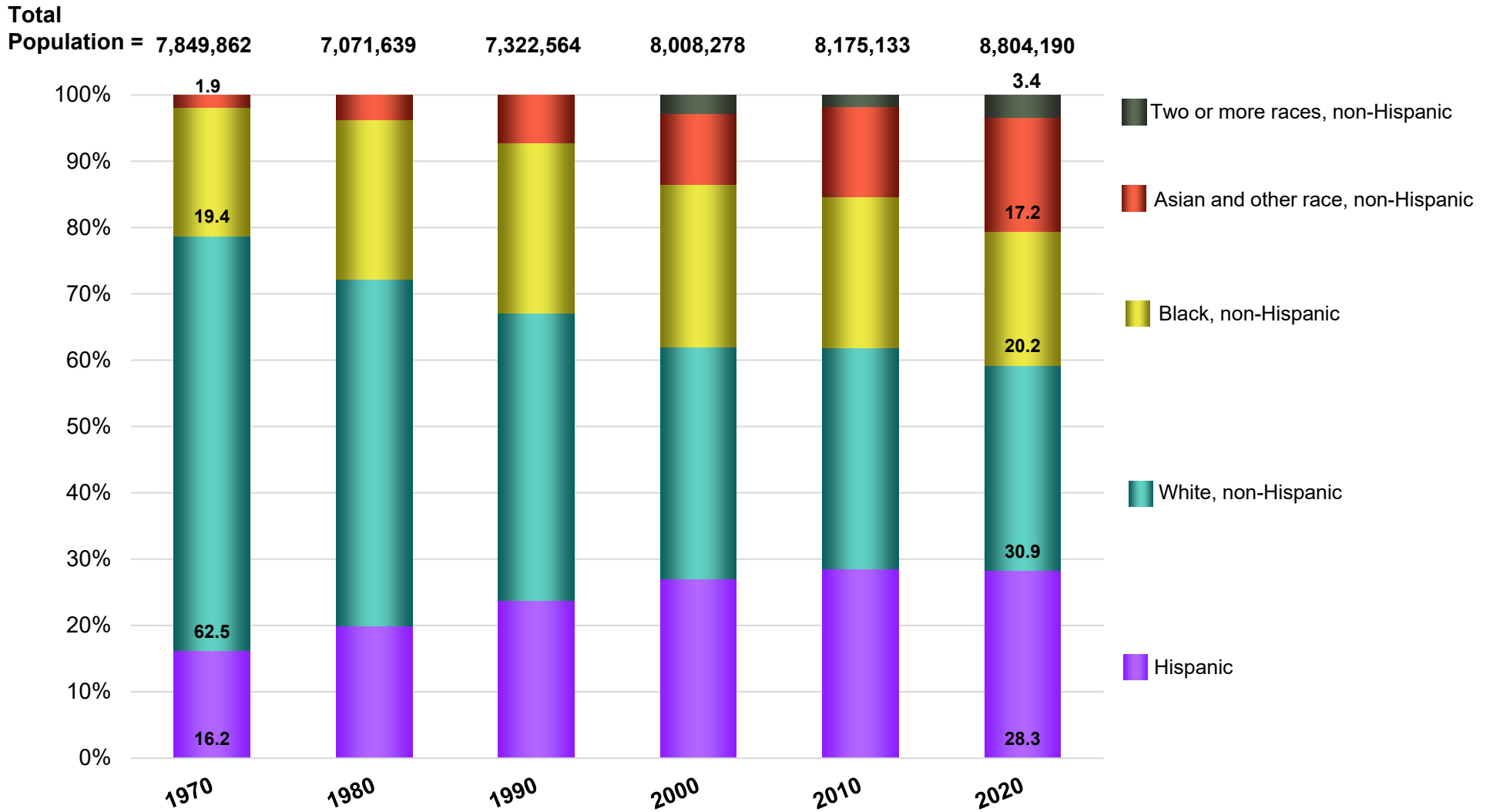


Population Change, 2010 to 2020

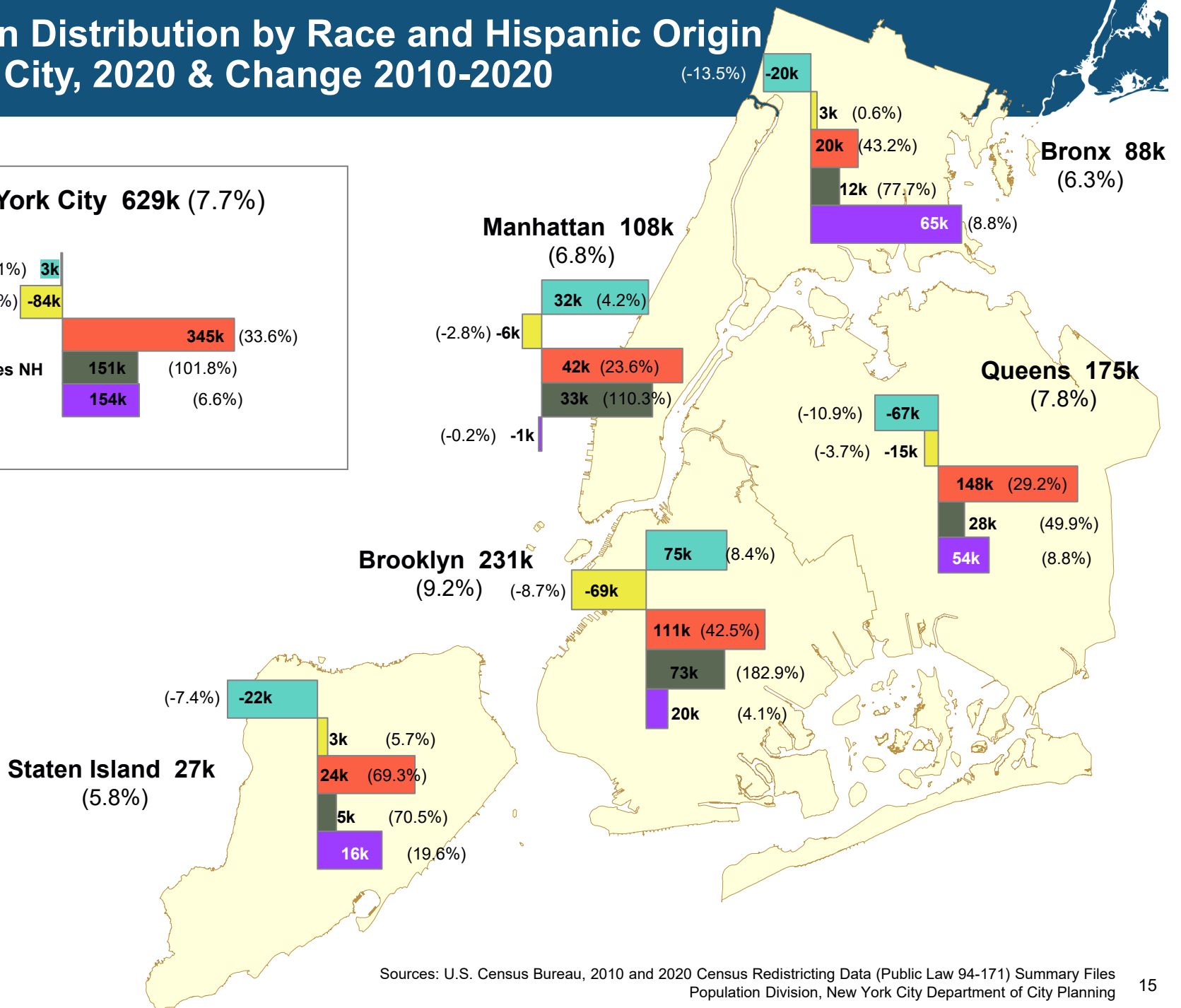
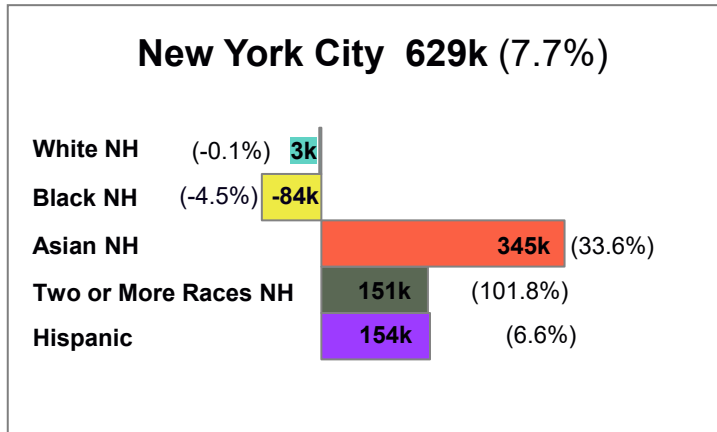

Population by Race/Hispanic Origin New York City, 1970-2020

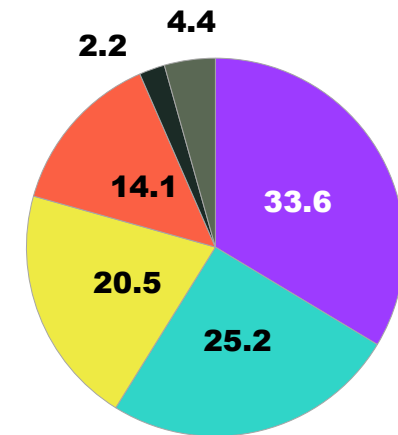
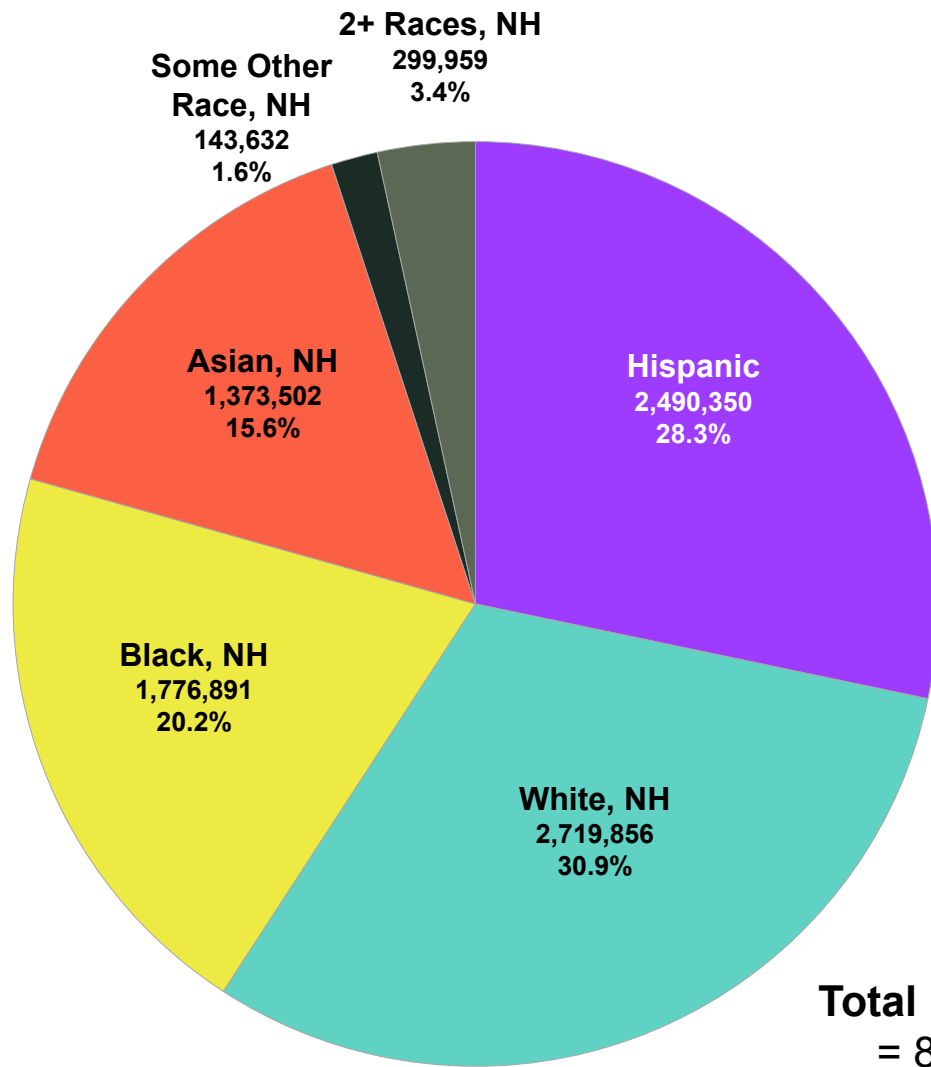


Population Distribution by Race and Hispanic Origin New York City, 2020 & Change 2010-2020

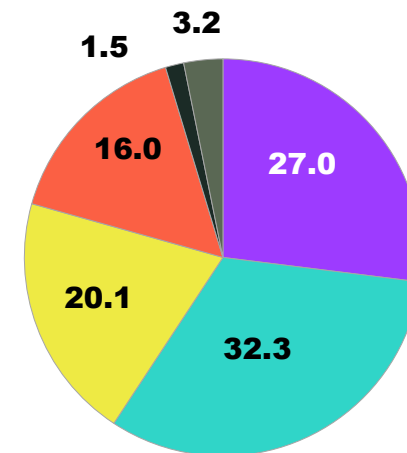


Percent Distribution by Race for Total Population & Selected Age Groups New York City, 2020

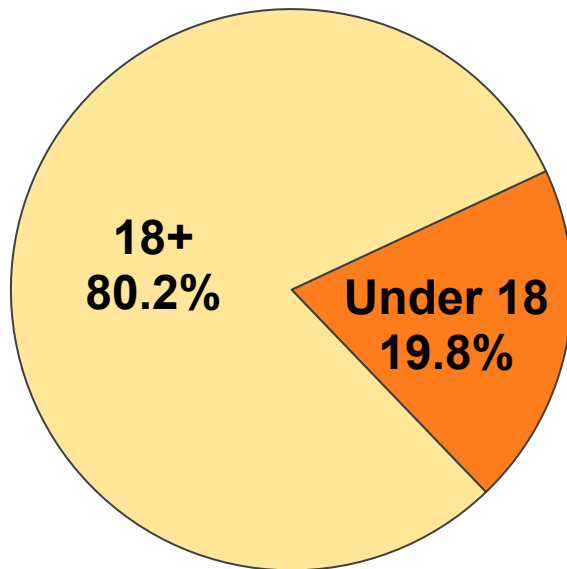

Population by Age Group New York City and Boroughs, 2020

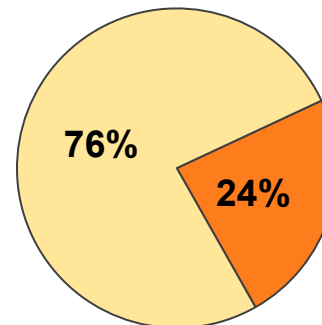

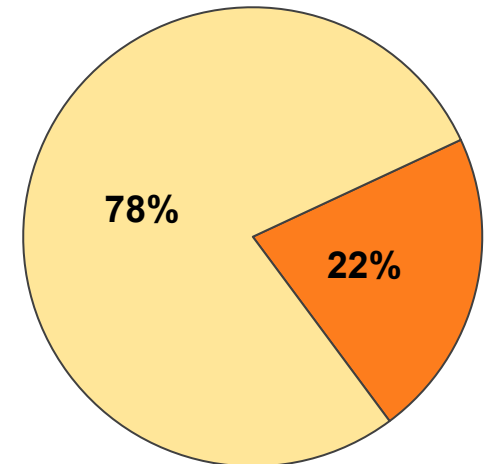

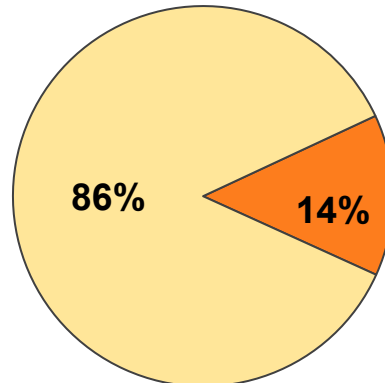

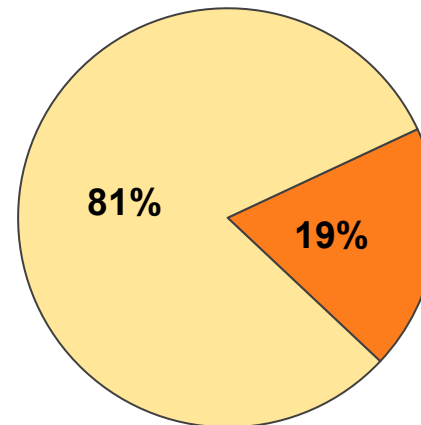

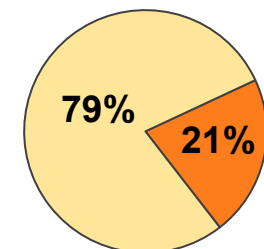
