Dear Redistricting Commission Members:

As a longtime District Leader and advocate for NYCHA developments within my district, I am writing to ask that you ensure our development and others like it remain part of Council District 2. The last proposal removed NYCHA developments from the 2nd District. Reinserting our development and others like it into that district will help ensure that our historically Latino representation in the City Council remains whole. The Lower East Side remains a strong community of color, particularly Latino families, and we deserve adequate representation in the City Council. By removing the NYCHA developments and not including more Latinos from the Lower East Side and Kips Bay, you will be diluting the possibility of having diverse representation in Lower Manhattan in the coming years.

I ask that you please consider this as you discuss your final proposals on September 22. It is imperative that the Latinos of the East Side maintain their voice in City governance.

I have attached a map showing NYCHA Development at the southern end of a proposed CCD2 map that would help maintain a strong Latino resident base throughout the district.
