## New York City Department of Correction Uniformed Personnel Demographic Data

As a condition of the funds in unit of appropriation numbers 001, 002, 003, and 004, the Department of Correction shall submit a report, no later than October 15, 2023, detailing the demographics of uniformed personnel, including gender and race. Such information shall be disaggregated by rank, gender, and race.

This report draws on personnel statistics from the Fourth quarter of NYC Fiscal Year 2023 recruitment data, reflecting information as of June 30, 2023<sup>1</sup>. The data presented in this report is self-reported by uniformed members of staff.

The Department of Correction has a total workforce of **7,687** employees. Of the total workforce, **6,118** are uniformed personnel. Of the total uniform personnel, **5,438** are Correction Officers and **680** are in civil service supervisory titles which includes Captains, Assistant Deputy Wardens, Deputy Wardens in Command, and Wardens.<sup>2</sup>

Within the rank of Correction Officer, **3,063** are male (56.33%) and **2,375** are female (43.67%). The overall categorization for race in the rank of Correction Officer is as follows:
