Pursuant to Local Law 84 of 2015, the Department is required to provide the number of incarcerated individuals who have been found guilty of violating departmental rules, but have not been placed in punitive segregation (PSEG), restrictive housing unit (RHU) or a clinical alternative to punitive segregation housing (CAPS), disaggregated by individuals with "M" designations<sup>1</sup> and those without "M" designations. The report must state how many individuals have been awaiting placement in the following categories: 1-5 days, 6-15 days, 16-30 days, 31-60 days, and 61 days or longer.

Please note: This list indicates the number of individuals who, as of the report date, have been found guilty of a Grade 1 and/or Grade 2 infraction(s) and sentenced to punitive segregation time, but were not in punitive segregation. This list does not indicate why an individual was not in punitive segregation on the report date. In addition, persons in PACE are excluded from these totals because they cannot be moved into PSEG, RHU, or CAPS until their treatment has finished.

Please also note: As of March 31, 2022, the Department no longer operates PSEG and RHU.
