#### **Subdivision c (Interventions)**

For the purposes of this report, the Department interprets "interventions" to mean verified instances in which staff use their hands, other parts of their body, or another physical method to restrain, subdue, or compel a visitor to act - or stop acting - in a particular manner. The only interventions recognized under this provision are those that occur in connection with the arrest of a visitor.

Arrests are authorized when a visitor's conduct violates city, state, or federal law. Arrests may also occur if a visitor attempts to introduce weapons or drug contraband into the facility or commits an assault on a staff member. For the purposes of this section, perpetrators are referred to as "members of service," and victims are referred to as "individuals subject to arrest."
