## New York City Department of Correction Annual Education Report School Year (2023 – 2024)

Pursuant to New York City Administrative Code §9-151, the Department is required to report on information related to adolescents and young adults located in a Department of Education facility controlled by the Department of Correction that offers educational programming to incarcerated individuals. In October 2018, all adolescents were transferred to the custody of the Administration of Children's Services (ACS), pursuant to Raise the Age legislation. The reporting period pertains to the 2023 - 2024 City school year (7/5/2023 - 6/27/2024).

1) The number of departmental infractions issued to adolescents at a Department of Education site, and the number of departmental infractions issued to young adults at a Department of Education school site, in total and disaggregated by the type of infraction, as defined by the Department:

There were 17 infractions issued to young adults at a Department of Education (DOE) site during the 2023 – 2024 school year. See Appendix 1 for disaggregated data.

2) The number of students prevented from attending educational programming by the Department of Correction because of a behavioral issue or an assault:

Due to behavioral concerns, 19 individuals were restricted from attending educational programming in the reporting period.

3) The number of assaults on staff at a Department of Education site, in total and disaggregated by whether such assault was committed by an adolescent or young adult:

There were no reported instances of assaults on staff committed by young adults on DOE school sites for the 2023 – 2024 school year.

4) The number of incidents of Use of Force A, B, and C at a Department of Education site, in total and disaggregated by whether such use of force was used on an adolescent or young adult.
