The New York City (“City”) Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (“NYC Health Department” or the “Agency”) is seeking an appropriately qualified Contractor to perform interior and exterior on-call electrical services on an as-needed basis at all NYC Health Department-owned/operated facilities located in the five (5) boroughs of the City of New York .

The purpose of this contract is to ensure that the electrical systems and equipment at the NYC Health Department Facilities are functioning in an energy efficient and safe manner.

The contract term is anticipated to be for six (6) years from August 1, 2026, to July 31, 2032, with no renewal options.

There will be a Pre-Bid Conference at 11:00 A.M. ET, on January 29, 2026, via teleconference. Attendance by vendors is optional, but strongly recommended. Please RSVP for the conference by 2:00 P.M.
