



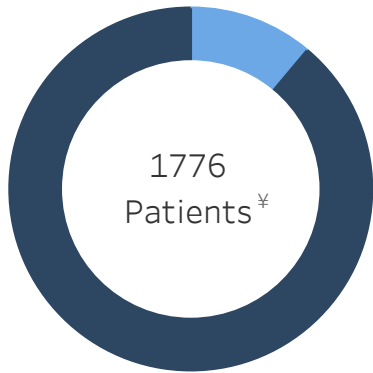

Not Suppressed: 198 (11.1%)

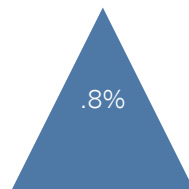
