## Fentanyl causes overdose deaths.

Fentanyl is commonly found in drugs sold as heroin.

Fentanyl has also been found in crack, cocaine,

methamphetamine and pills from nonmedical sources.

## Reduce your overdose risk:

- Test your drugs using fentanyl test strips.
  - If positive, consider not using. If you do plan to use, start with a small amount and go slowly.
- Avoid using alone. Take turns or call the Never Use Alone hotline at 877-696-1996.
- Avoid mixing drugs.
- Keep naloxone ready and on hand.
