- · Carry naloxone. Naloxone can reverse an opioid overdose. Prevent opioid overdose:
- Avoid mixing drugs. Mixing opioids with alcohol and Xanax, Valium and Klonopin increases the risk of overdose. · Avoid using alone. If you do, have someone check on you.

The best way to prevent an overdose is to not use drugs.
