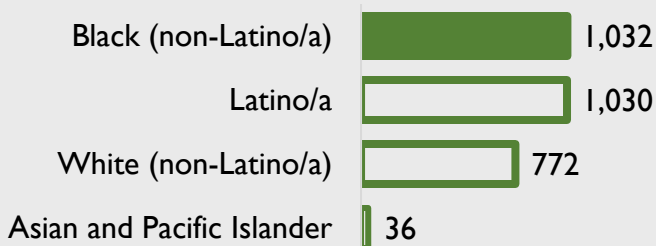


# Overdose Deaths Among Black New Yorkers, 2022

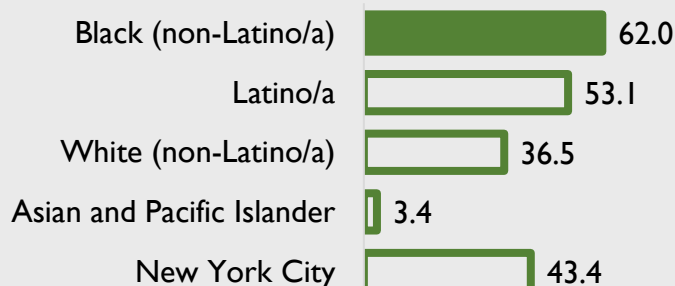
**1,032** Black New Yorkers died of a drug overdose.

Black New Yorkers had the largest number of overdose deaths.



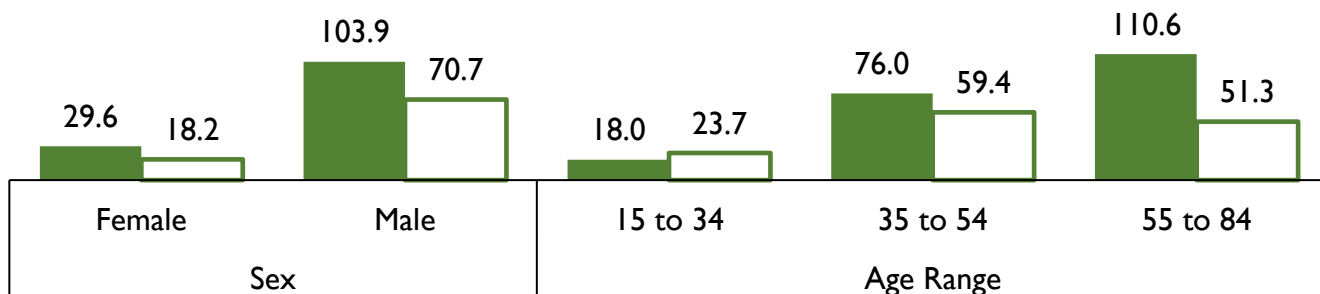
**62.0** Black New Yorkers per 100,000 died of a drug overdose.

Black New Yorkers had the highest rate of overdose death (per 100,000 residents).

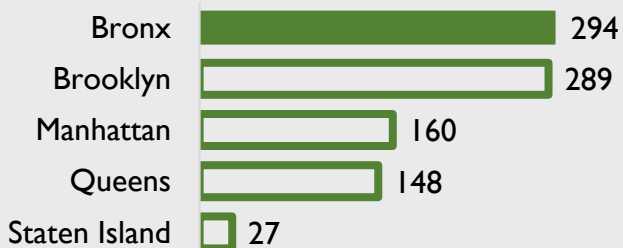


Rates of overdose death among Black New Yorkers were the highest among males and people ages 55 to 84.

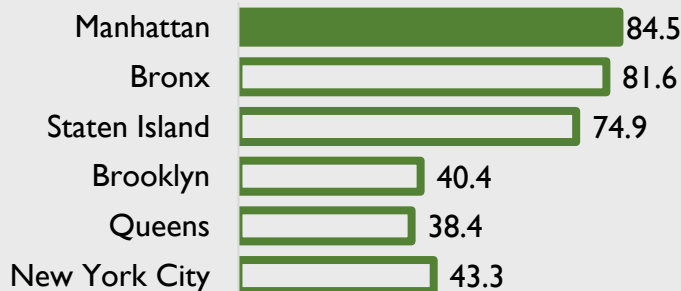

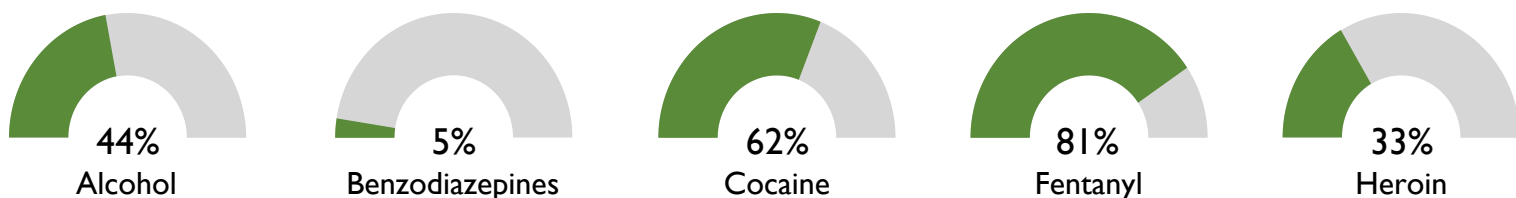
The Bronx had the largest number of overdose deaths among Black residents.
