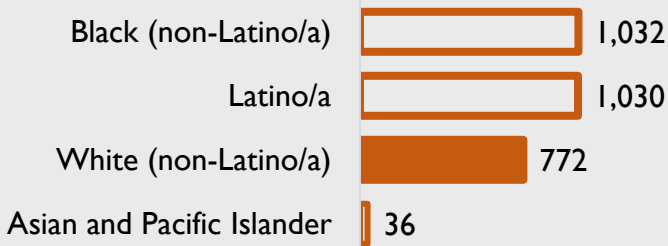


# Overdose Deaths Among White New Yorkers, 2022

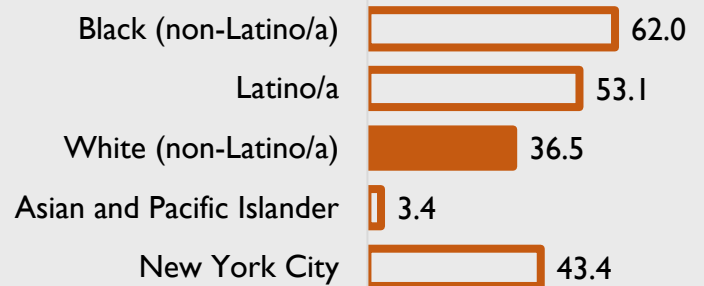
**772** White New Yorkers died of a drug overdose.

**36.5** White New Yorkers per 100,000 died of a drug overdose.

White New Yorkers had the third largest number of overdose deaths.

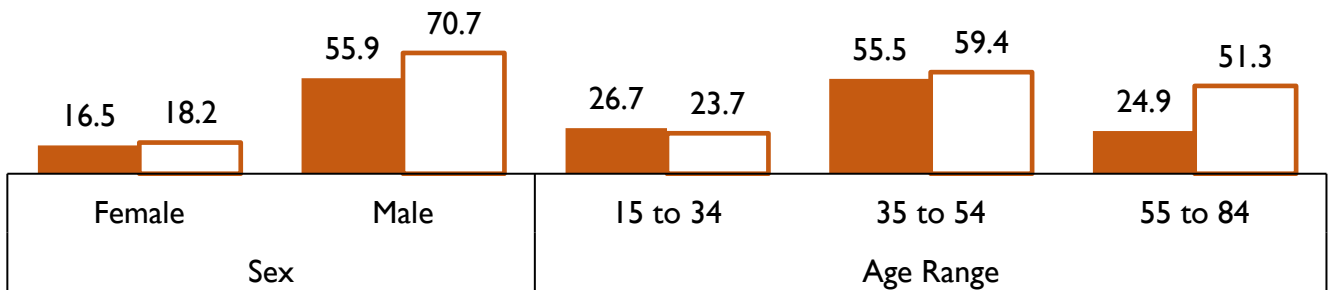


White New Yorkers had the third highest rate of overdose death (per 100,000 residents).

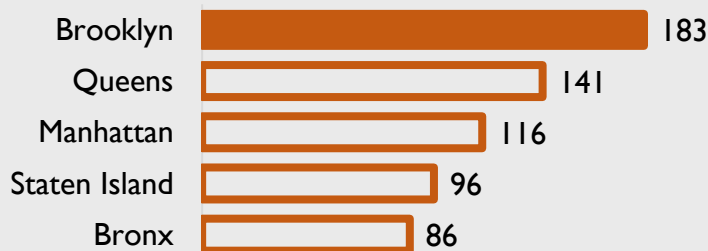


Rates of overdose death among white New Yorkers were the highest among males and people ages 35 to 54.

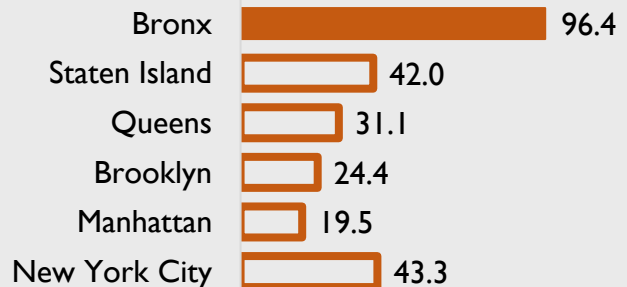
■ White New Yorkers ■ New York City overall



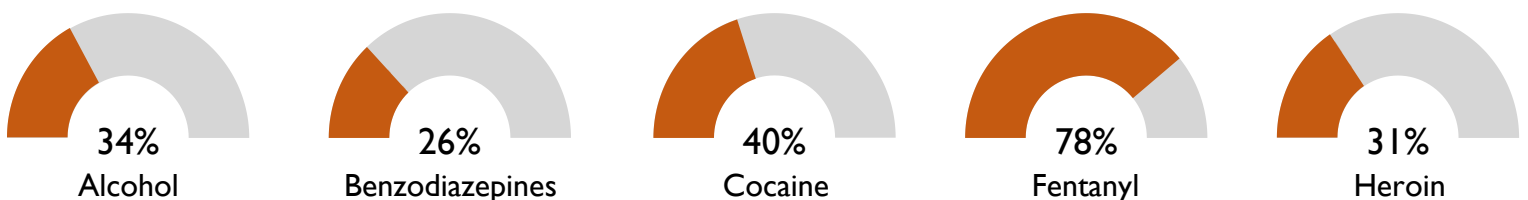
Brooklyn had the largest number of overdose deaths among white residents.
