691 White residents died of a drug overdose

32.7 per 100,000 White residents died of a drug overdose

White New Yorkers had the largest number of overdose deaths.




White New Yorkers had the third highest rate of overdose death (per 100,000 residents).




Rates of overdose death among White New Yorkers were the highest among males and people ages 35-54.




Queens had the largest number of overdose deaths among White residents.
