## Get vaccinated for Hep B!

Hep B is a virus that infects the liver and can cause liver disease, cancer and death. Hep B can be passed from one person to another through blood, semen and vaginal fluids.

There is no cure, but the vaccine is safe and can protect you from getting Hep B. You must complete the two- or three-dose vaccine series to be fully protected.

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## Get tested to know your Hep B status!

230,000 people in New York City are living with Hep B but may not be aware of their infection and may not feel or look sick.

Most people living with Hep B got it at birth. Other common ways to get Hep B are sharing or reusing needles, injection or medical equipment, or having unprotected sex.

Finding out early and getting care from a Hep B health care provider are important to help you live a long and healthy life.
