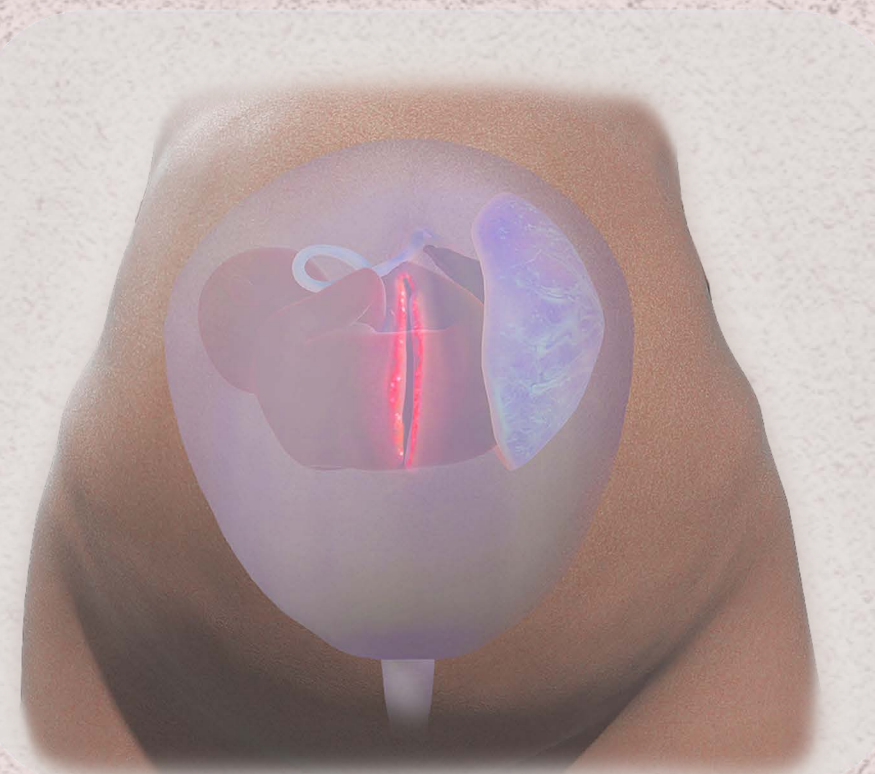
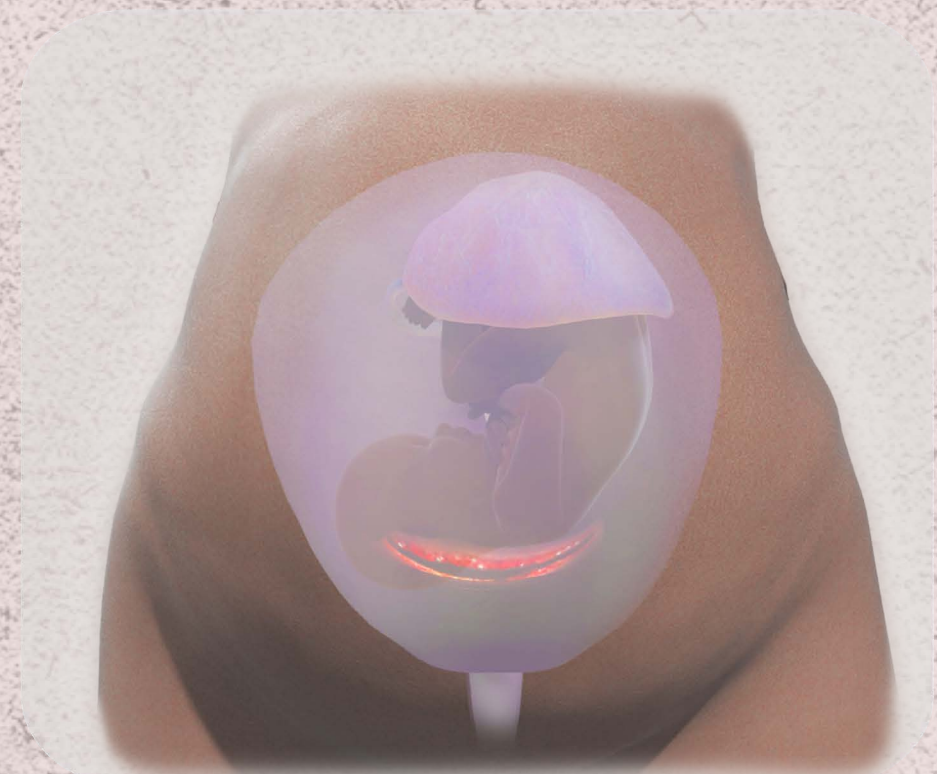


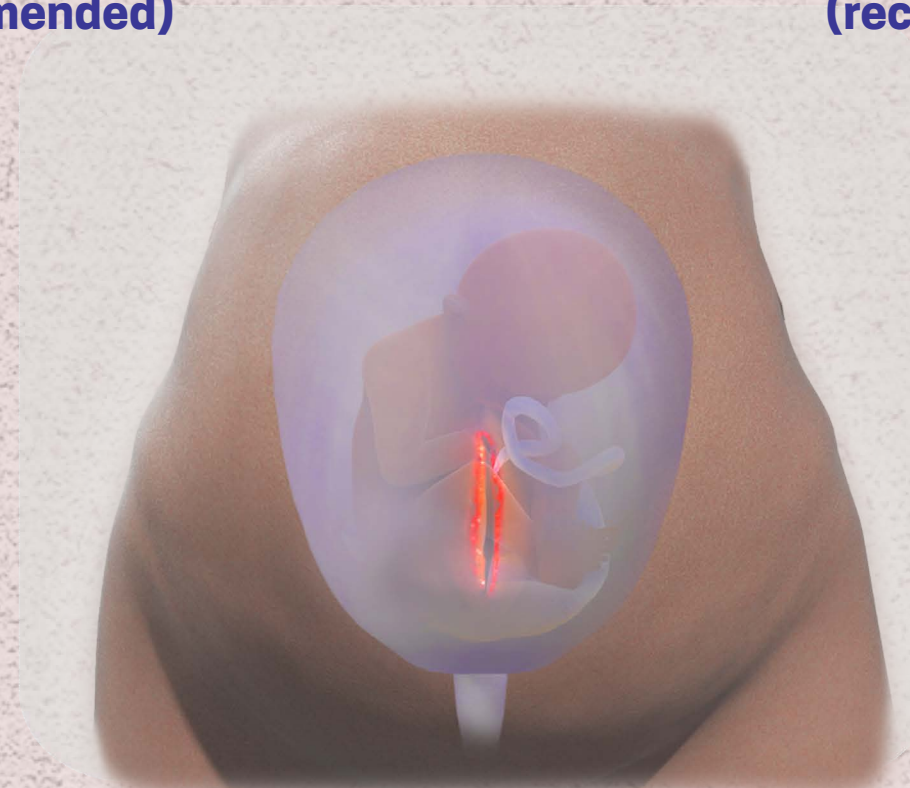
What Is VBAC (Vaginal Birth After Cesarean)?
