**Be compassionate and empathetic** in every interaction with patients.



Use plain language and create space for patients to take an active role in shaping their care.

**Embrace humility** and focus on readiness to learn and care for patients of varying backgrounds.

**Refuse stereotypes** and speak up when you observe a colleague relying on implicit bias. **Be self-aware.** Remain conscious of your stress levels, which can magnify bias and stereotypes.
