Our school regulates food that is served at class parties and other school celebrations. "Competitive foods" refers to food and beverage items — sold to students at vending machines, school stores, school fundraisers and school-based kitchens — that do not contain any artificial sweeteners, caffeine or carbonation. Foods and beverages sold in these settings are governed by Chancellor's Regulation A-812. As of February 2010, only foods and beverages that meet the New York City Department of Education's (NYC DOE) SchoolFood guidelines can be offered for sale during school hours.
