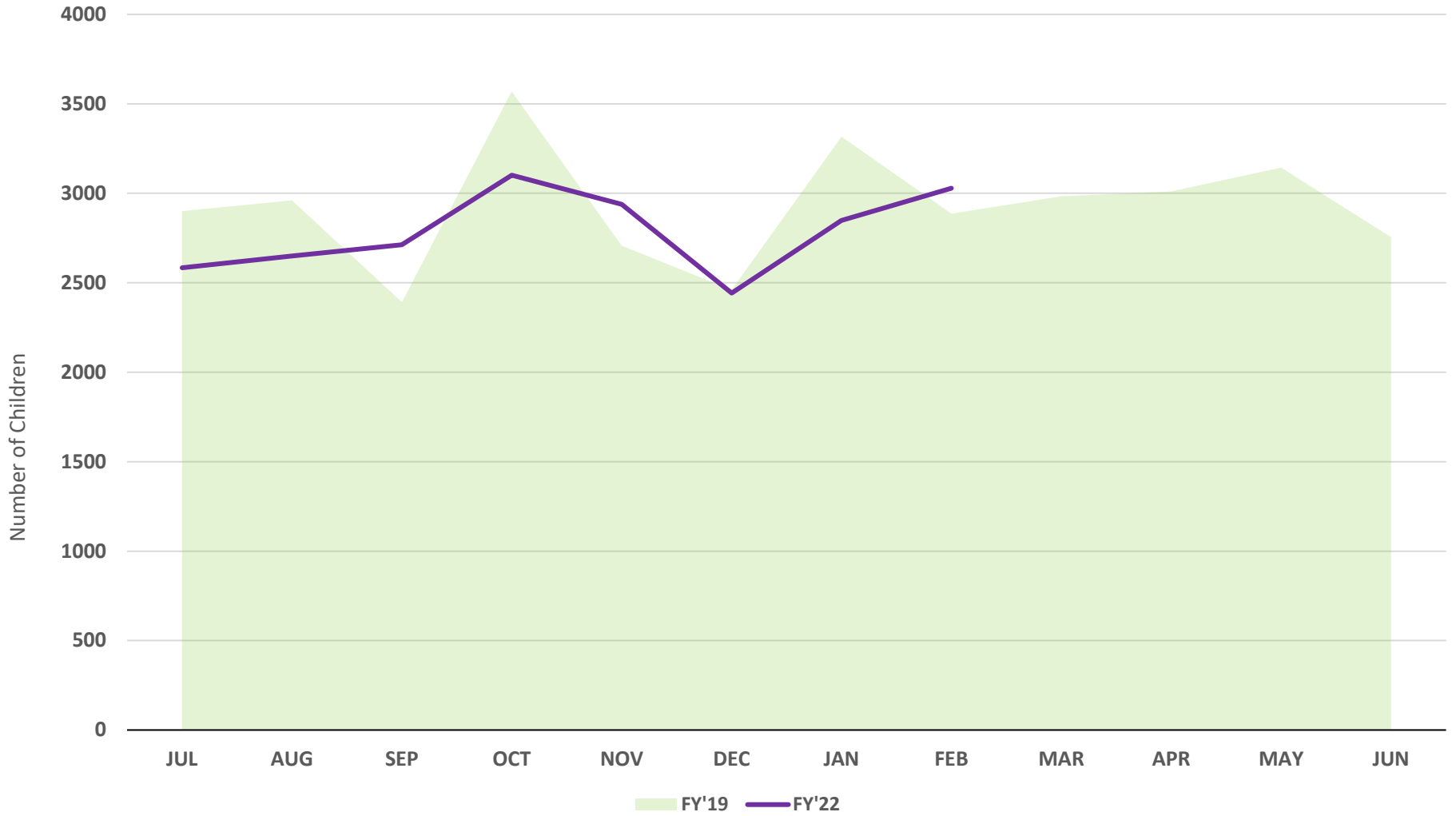

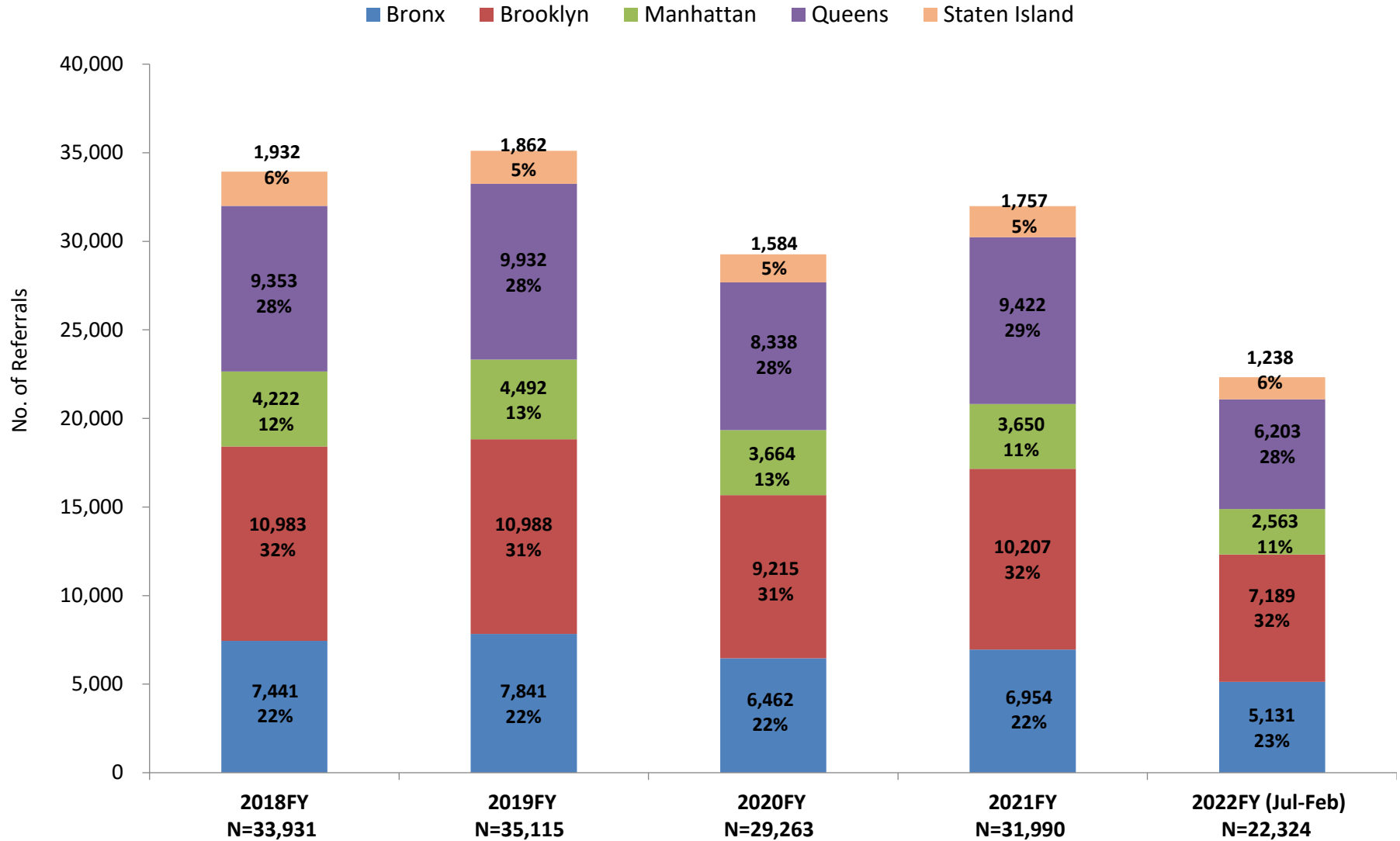

FY2022 vs. FY2019



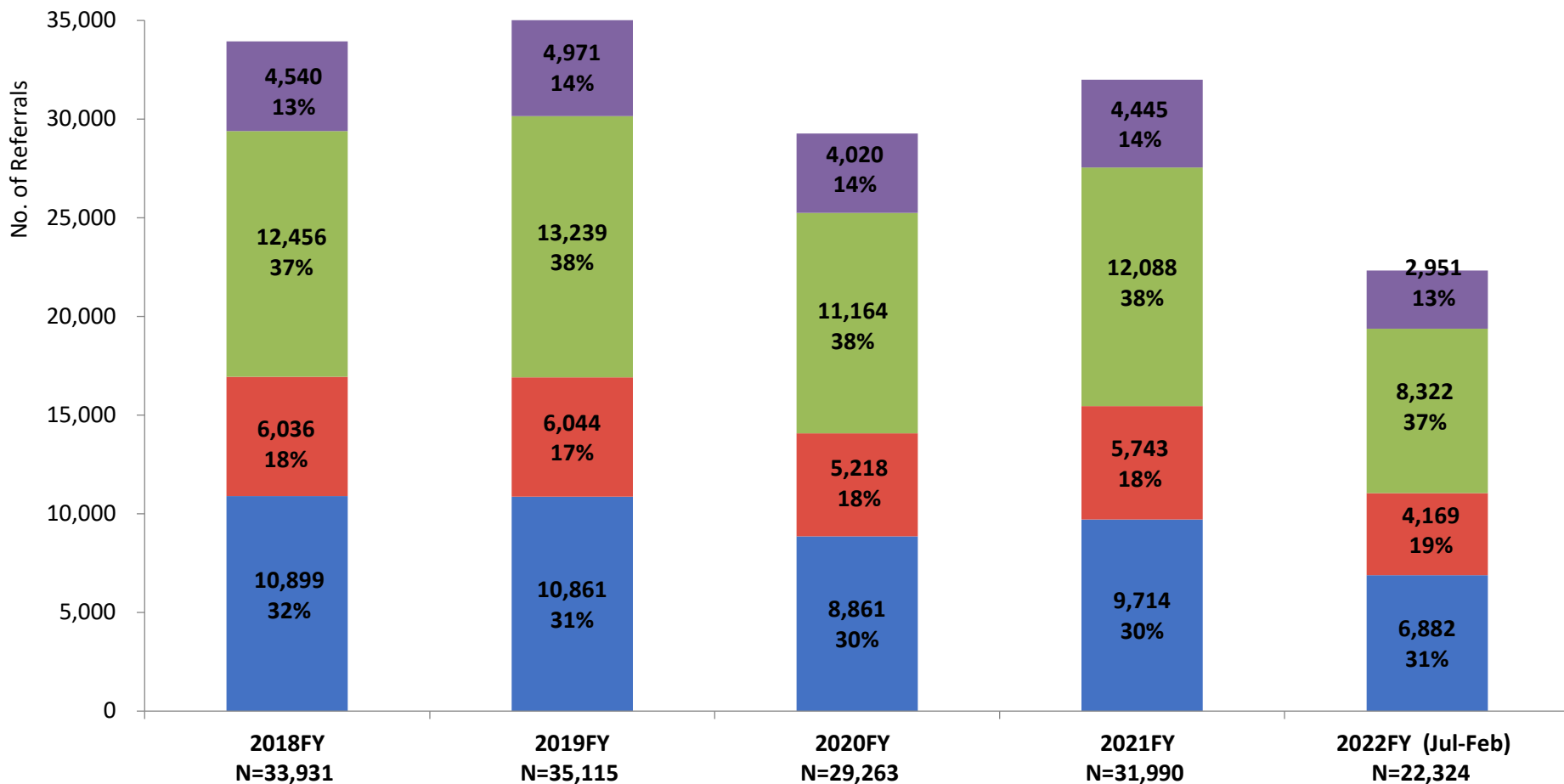
Number of New and Re-Referrals Per Fiscal Year, by Borough July 2017-Feb 2022



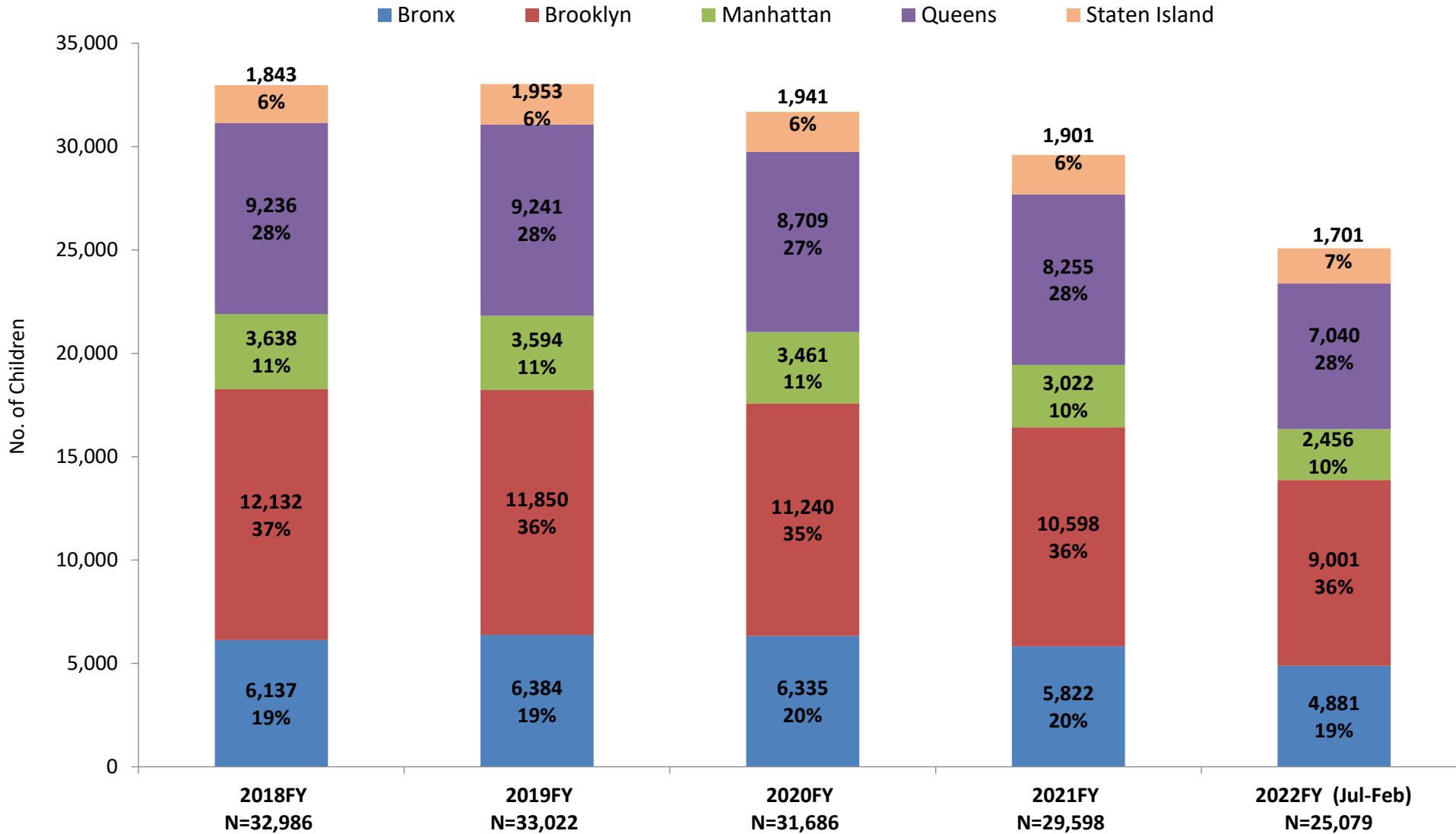

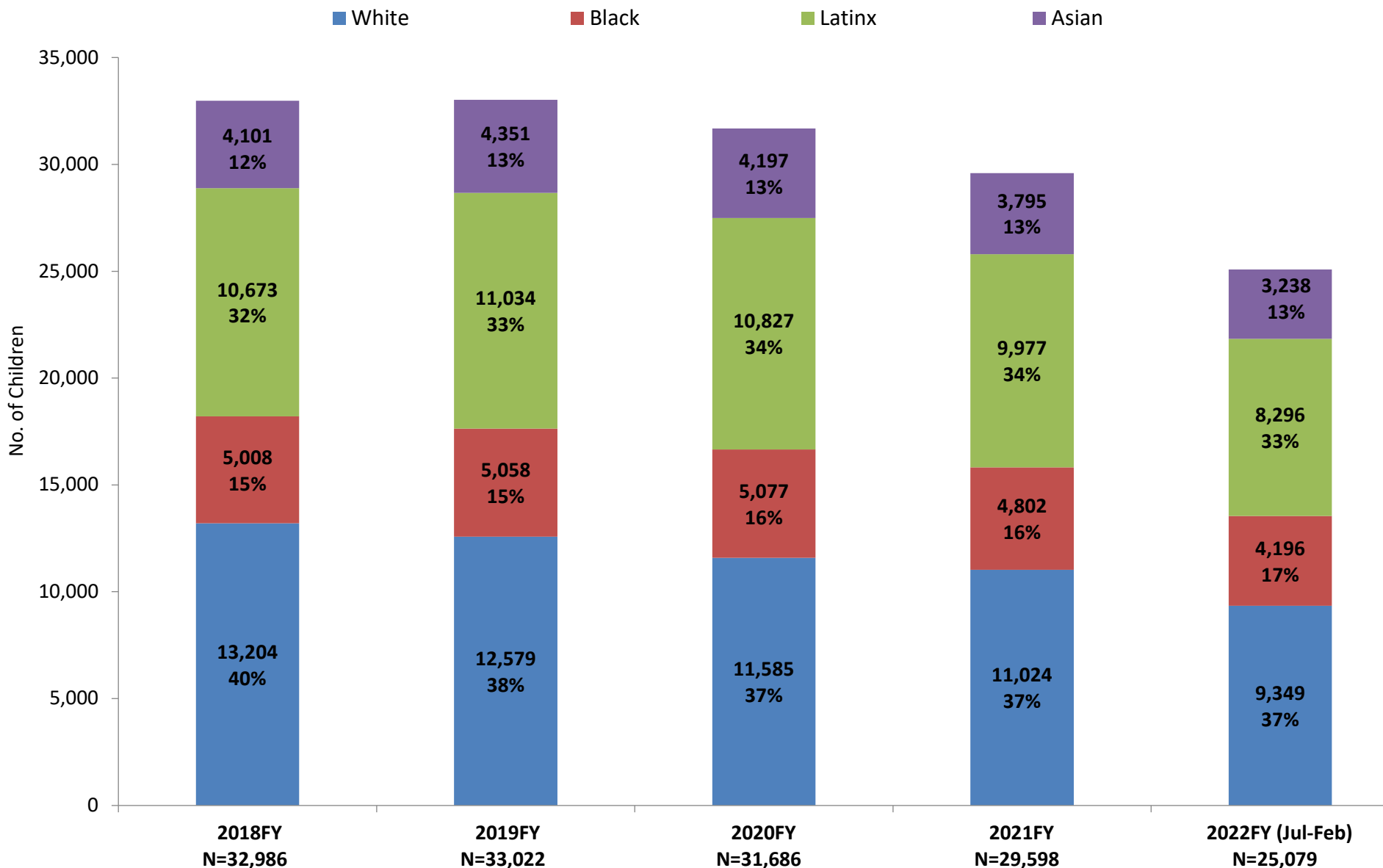


Number of Children Receiving General Services Per Fiscal Year, by Borough July 2017-February 2022

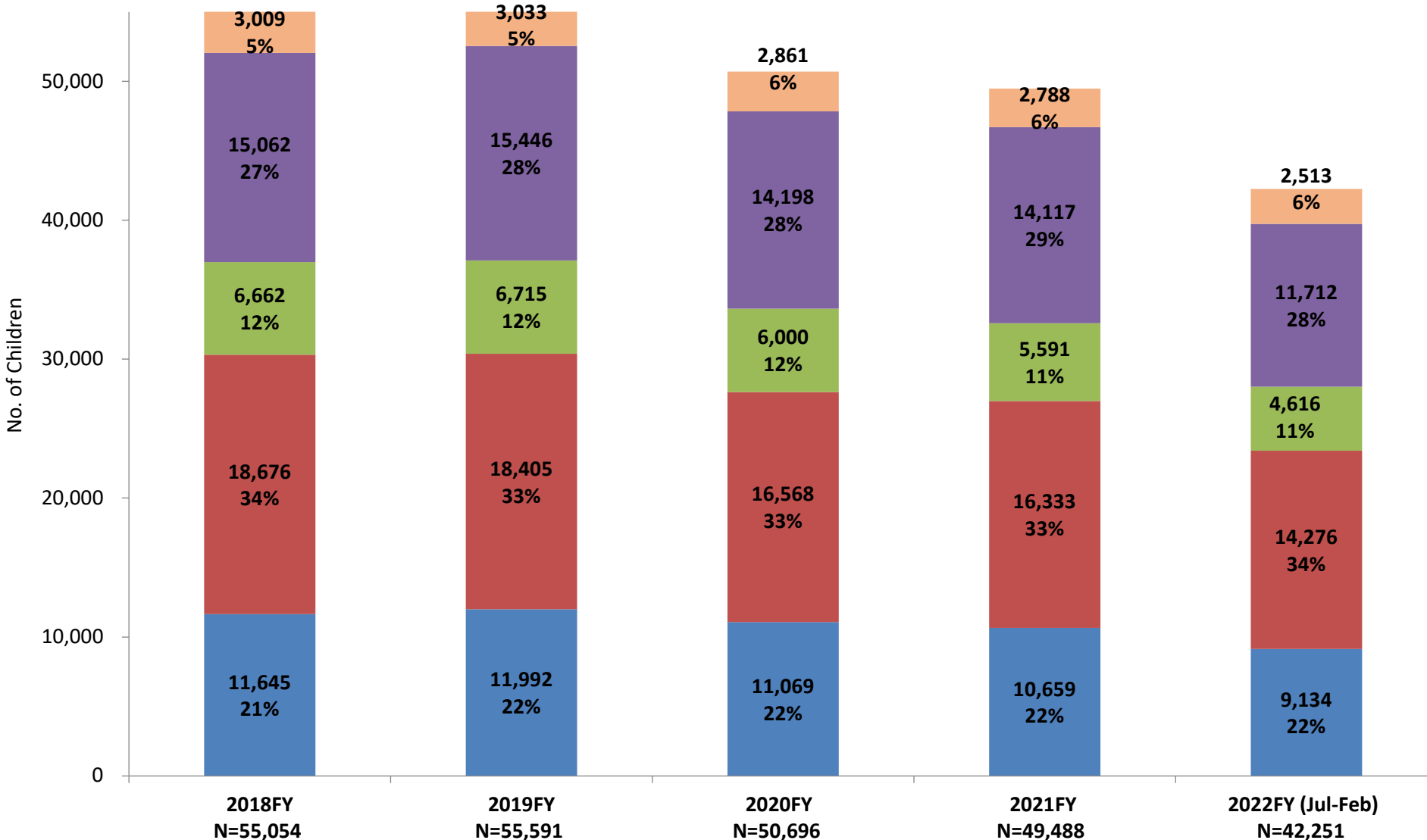
Number of Children Receiving General Services Per Fiscal Year, by Race and Ethnicity, July 2017-February 2022



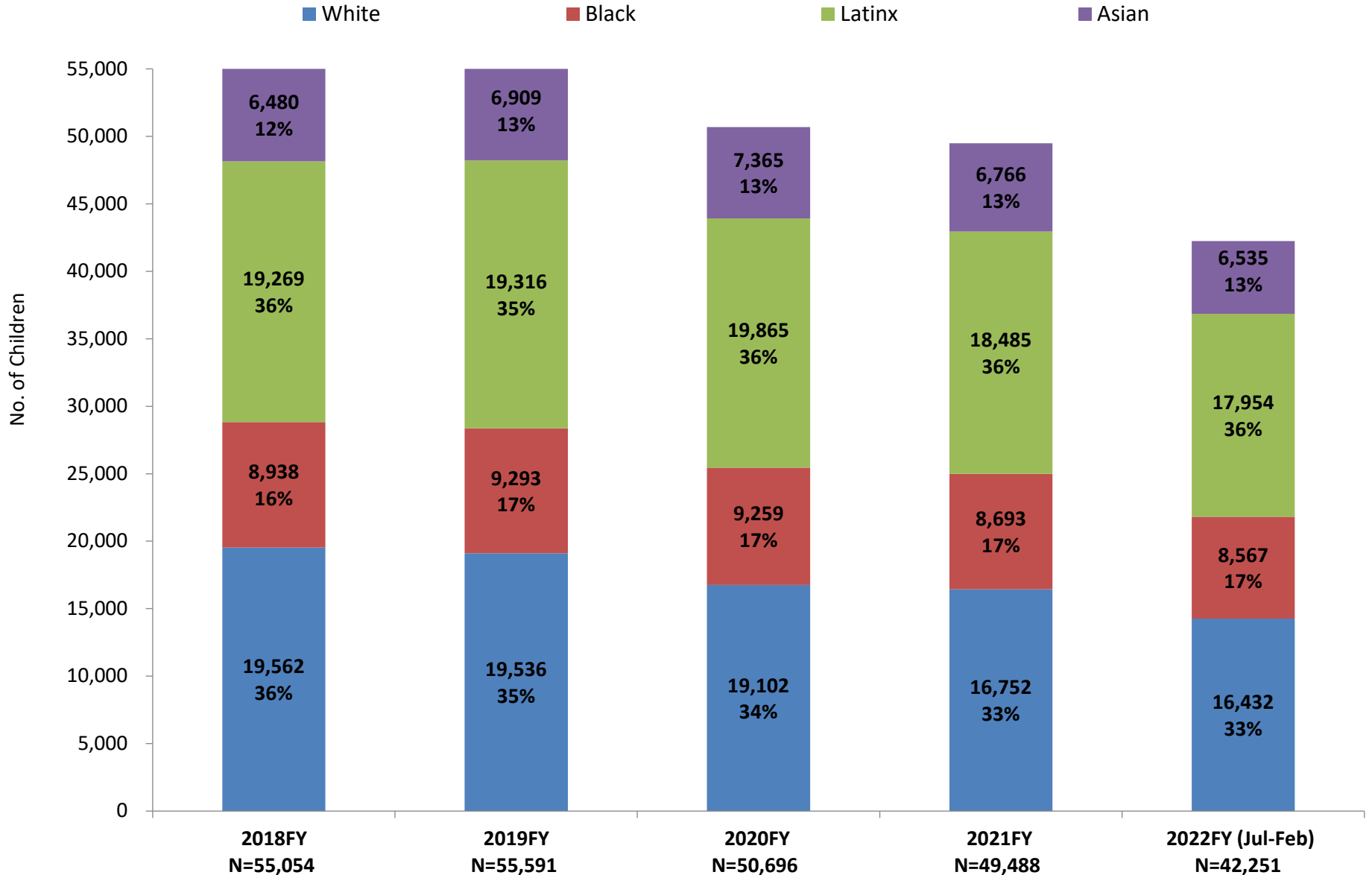

Children Receiving Any Type of Service Per Fiscal Year, by Borough: Service Coordination, Evaluation and/or General Services July 2017-February 2022

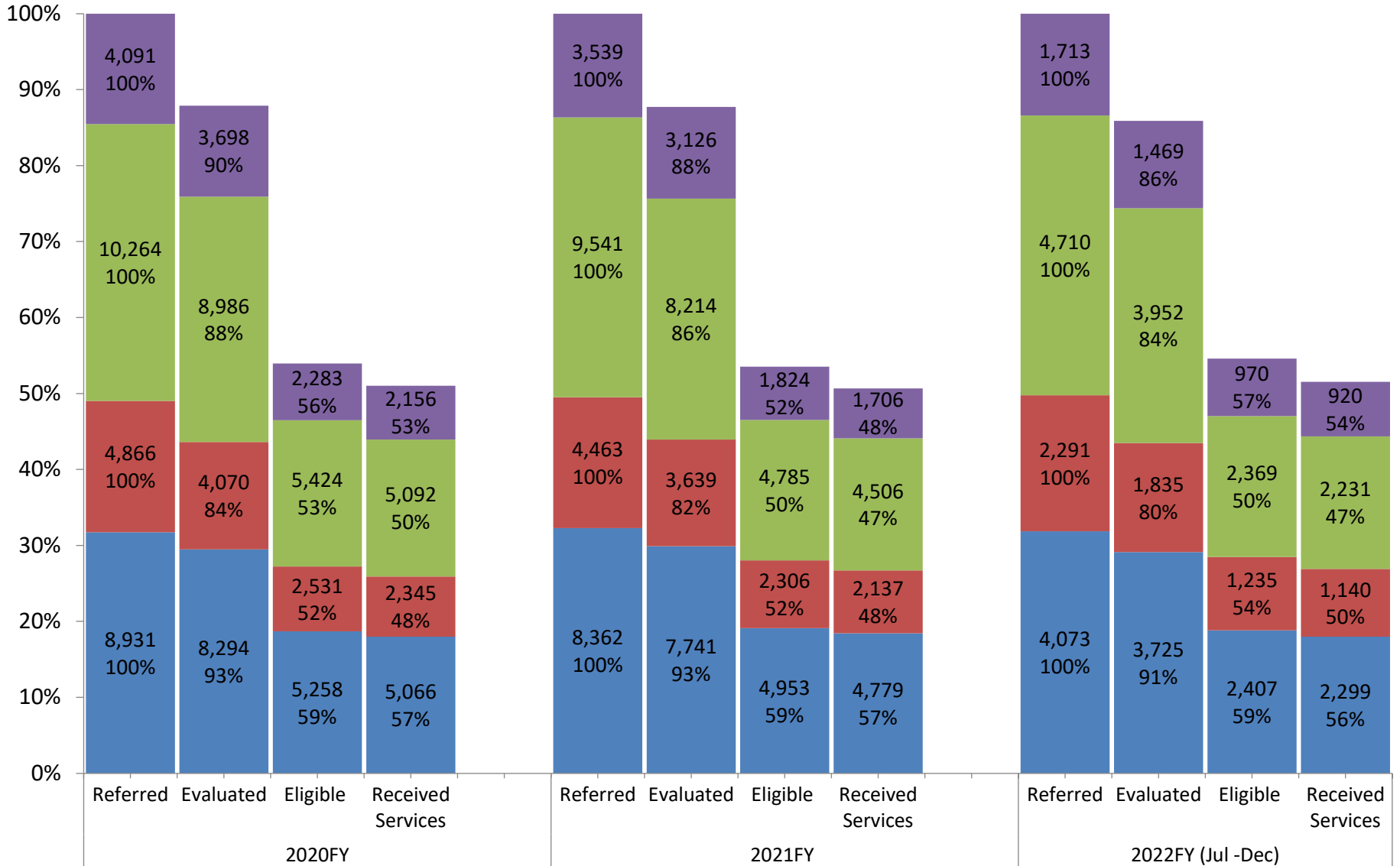

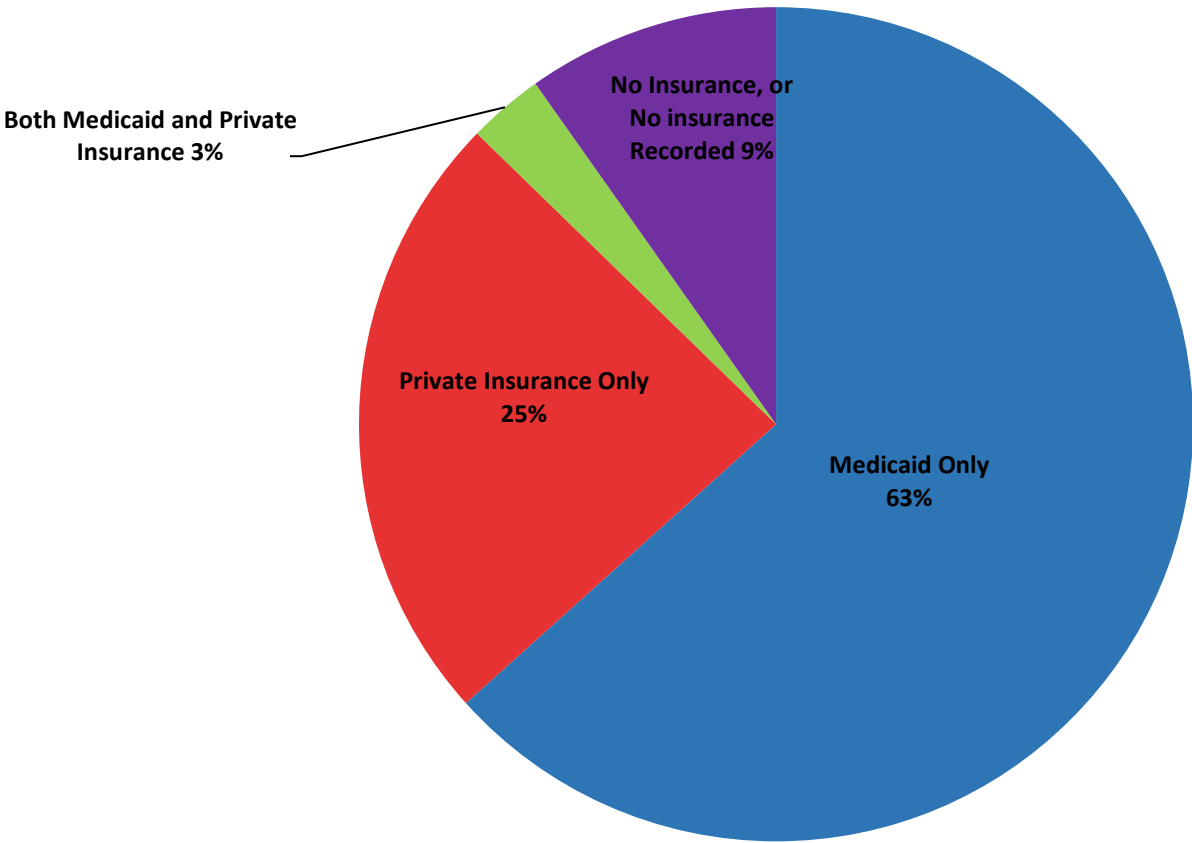
