



#### Number of Children Referred to El by Month FY2022 vs. FY2019







### Number of New and Re-Referrals Per Fiscal Year, by Borough July 2017-May 2022




#### Number of Children Receiving General Services Per Fiscal Year, by Borough July 2017- May 2022

by Race and Ethnicity July 2017-May 2022




