NALOXONE (NARCAN) FOR OVERDOSE PREVENTION

Naloxone (Narcan) is a safe medication that can save someone's life by reversing the effects of an opioid overdose.



- Only works on opioids, such as heroin, prescription painkillers and fentanyl, but is safe to use even if opioids are not present.
- Available as an easyto-use nasal spray
