Dear Provider:

We want to make you aware of the vaccine (CVX) codes for the flu vaccines that are available for the 2026–2027 season. Please share this notice and the attached table with your billing and technology staff and any billing system or electronic health record (EHR) vendor so that your system's vaccine codes can be updated. Regularly updating your system will enable you to report vaccines correctly to the Citywide Immunization Registry (CIR).

If you are reporting immunizations directly from your EHR via the CIR HL7 Web Service, reach out to your EHR vendor or onsite technical contact for assistance reporting the Sale NDC11 to the CIR and note the following:

1. When reporting the [National Drug Code number](#) (NDC) for an immunization administered, you must report the **unit of sale NDC11 value**, which can be found on the vaccine box. For example, a dose of Fluzone Trivalent, preservative-free (2026/2027 flu season, CVX 140) would be reported with the **Sale NDC11 value of 49281-0426-50** (as opposed to the unit of use **NDC11 value** of 49281-0426-88).
2. Report the vaccine HL7 Manufacturers of Vaccines (MVX) code, vaccine (CVX) code, and NDC together when reporting an administered vaccine.
3. The MVX code for a vaccine is the manufacturer that is approved under the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) Biologics License Application (BLA) for that product. In some cases, a subsidiary or manufacturing partner is listed as the manufacturer code by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to be used for ordering vaccine.

Please take this opportunity to review your vaccine codes. Check for miscoding errors and missing codes. Refer to the CDC NDC Crosswalk Tables, CVX, and CPT Vaccine Code Sets [here](#).
