<u>*Rats-*</u> All rats will eat varying amounts of feed depending on their genetic origin. Larger strains can eat up to 30 grams per day. Smaller strains will eat up to 15 grams per day.

<u>Mice:</u> Adult mice can eat up to 5 grams of pelleted ration daily. Some of the larger strains may eat as much as 8 grams per day per animal.

GOOD BITES[™] contraception is reversible thus to sustain population reduction a maintenance level of pellets should be deployed, check feeders to insure pellet presence. The required maintenance number of pellets depends on the size population on which to maintain control.

Instructions for Use: Check feeders regularly to ensure GoodBites are available in the quantities listed above to satisfy all rodents present. As the population diminishes, the frequency of fills will decline. We suggest weekly checks when first using. A fully filled feeder holds 650grams of Good Bites ™
