

Family Tree/Link to Decedent

To show the connection from yourself to the decedent (deceased person), write your full name in the center box at the bottom of the tree. From that box, draw a line connecting other boxes so the family tree chart shows your relationship back to the decedent. Use as many boxes as necessary. For each box you use, write the first and last name of the person and their relationship to you (for example, father, grandmother). You do not have to draw your entire family.
