STATEMENT FROM DOI COMMISSIONER ROSE GILL HEARN ON THE ARREST OF TWO CITY EMPLOYEES, INCLUDING A DEPUTY SHERIFF, WHO WERE ARRESTED IN A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER SCAM

-- They sold Social Security numbers of New York City Kids --

DOI Commissioner Rose Gill Hearn said, "These two City employees misused their positions and authority in a scheme to make money by unlawfully disclosing social security numbers belonging to underprivileged New York City children and selling them for use on fraudulently prepared tax returns."

DOI is one of the oldest law-enforcement agencies in the country. The agency investigates and refers for prosecution City employees and contractors engaged in corrupt or fraudulent activities or unethical conduct. Investigations may involve any agency, officer, elected official or employee of the City, as well as those who do business with or receive benefits from the City.
