STATEMENT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF INVESTIGATION

Contrary to some news reports, DOI did not state that the vetting of Bernard Kerik for appointment to NYPD Commissioner was improper. He completed the background questionnaire in 1998 upon appointment as Department of Correction Commissioner. Subsequently, as required, Mr. Kerik completed the annual DOI and Conflict of Interest Board's financial disclosure forms for calendar years 1998 through 2001.

DOI is one of the oldest law-enforcement agencies in the country. The agency investigates and refers for prosecution City employees and contractors engaged in corrupt or fraudulent activities or unethical conduct. Investigations may involve any agency, officer, elected official or employee of the City, as well as those who do business with or receive benefits from the City.
