MS. BADEA: Good morning and welcome. My name is Anissa Badea, and I'm an attorney in the Bureau of Legal Affairs of the Department of Sanitation. Thank you for attending this public hearing this morning.

DSNY is conducting this remote hearing in accordance with the requirements of the City
Administrative Procedure Act. The purpose of this hearing is to receive comments from the public on DSNY's proposed rule relating to the implementation of the second and third commercial waste zones.

This rule was published by DSNY in the City record on April 23, 2025, with a scheduled hearing date of today, May 23, 2025. Additionally, DSNY e-mailed copies of the rule to all New York City local elected officials and the City's 59 community boards, media, and interested parties and published the proposed rule on its

3	In 2019, New York City enacted		
4	Local Law 199 requiring the		
5	establishment of a new program for the		
6	collection of commercial waste. The		
7	program knows the commercial waste		
8	zone (CWZ) program is a safe,		
9	efficient, and competitive collection		
10	system designed to provide high		
11	quality service to New York City		
12	businesses, while advancing the City's		
13	waste diversion and sustainability		
14	goals. Pursuant to Local Law 199		
15	codified in Title 16-B of the New York		
16	City Administrative Code, the		
17	geographic area of New York City has		
18	been divided into 20 commercial waste		
19	zones.		
20	Pursuant to request for		
21	proposals process, three private		
22	carters providing commercial waste		
23	collection services were selected by		
24	the Department to serve businesses		
25	within each CWZ, and five carters were

2	selected to provide containerized			
3	commercial waste collection services			
4	from dumpsters and compactors			
5	city-wide. The selected carters were			
6	referred to as awardees. The			
7	resulting contract with the awardees			
8	include standards for pricing,			
9	customer service, safety,			
10	environmental health, and requirements			
11	to promote the City's commitment to			
12	recycling and sustainability.			
13	Local Law 199 requires the			
14	Department to issue rules setting			
15	forth an implementation start date and			
16	a final implementation date for each			
17	commercial waste zone established.			
18	Different implementation start dates			
19	and implementation end dates may be			
20	established for different commercial			
21	waste zones. The Department			
22	previously set the implementation			
23	start and end dates for the first			
24	zone, Queens Central, with an			
25	implementation start date of

implementation end date of January 2, 2025.

This rule sets the implementation start date and final implementation date for the next two zones to be implemented: Bronx East and Bronx West. Subsequent rules set the implementation dates for the remaining zones. DSNY's authority for the rules is found in Section 753 and Section 1043(q) of the New York City Charter in Title 16-B of the New York City Administrative Code.
