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

Q&A #1 for the 2026 Request for Proposals (“RFP”) for Commercial Waste Zone Midtown North and Manhattan Southwest Implementation

- 1. How would DSNY evaluate the pricing component, given that the pricing range from the prior RFP results has already been disclosed?**

Answer: Consistent with the RFP, Proposers’ Price Proposals will be evaluated based on the competitiveness of the proposed pricing structure in comparison with other proposals received for the relevant zone(s) and the maximum rate schedules of existing Awardees in those zone(s).

Proposers are encouraged to review the maximum rate schedules for existing Awardees in the relevant zone(s) when preparing their Price Proposals. Proposers can find a list of existing Awardees and a maximum rate comparison tool for existing Awardees at the DSNY website at www.nyc.gov/cwz.

- 2. Will the selected zone awardee be subject to the exact same contract terms, including the administrative fee requirement?**

Answer: Appendix C of the RFP contains the agreement that selected Awardee(s) will sign with the Department, which includes the same contract terms as existing Awardees’ agreements with the Department.

All Awardees, including existing and new Awardees, are required to pay the same annual administrative fee. This fee is set by rule in Section 20-03 of Title 16 of the Rules of the City of New York.

- 3. What are the insurance requirements for selected zone awardee(s)?**

Answer: The insurance requirements for Awardees are contained in Article XIX of the CWZ Award Agreement (Appendix C of the RFP). Proposers are not required to meet the insurance requirements in order to submit a Proposal but will be required to meet them if selected as an Awardee.

- 4. Does Question 4 in Attachment 9 relate strictly to a name change? In other words, is it asking if “Joe Jones” changed his name to “Joe Smith” or is it asking for disclosure of the fact that Joe Jones is an Officer of both Carter A and Carter B?**

Answer: Question 4 of Attachment 9 is asking whether any Proposer, Designated Carters, principals, or staff required to be disclosed in Questions 1 through 3 of Attachment 9 have conducted business under a different name during the preceding five years. For example, if a Key Staff member disclosed in Question 2 conducted business under a different name up until two years ago, that Key Staff member’s former name must be disclosed in Question 4. Question 4 is not inquiring regarding other affiliations of the Proposer, Designated Carters, principals, or staff.
