## <u>09 — NDA Safety Awareness and Crime Prevention Logic Model</u>

**Mission and vision:** Community members will identify a priority need within the NDA related to safety awareness and crime prevention, including issues of domestic and gender-based violence and interpersonal conflict resolution and, by working with funded contractors, will raise awareness of the issue and develop coordinated prevention and intervention strategies to address it.

### Assets, inputs, and resources

Community-based organizations provide:

- Organizational commitment, mission alignment, oversight, and experience
- Appropriate staff, including a program director (30%) and program assistant (100%)
- Partnerships to support meeting the needs of the community
- Knowledge of the community
- Ability to leverage resources
- Program facility within the NDA or within one-half mile of the NDA

#### DYCD provides:

- Funding
- Monitoring and evaluation
- Professional learning, frameworks and tools
- Partnership supports
- CSBG/ROMA framework approach and support

#### **Activities**

#### Participants:

- Required: Leadership Skills, Volunteer Recruitment and Training.
- Year 1: Community members are recruited and engage in a process to identify an issue and devise strategies to address it.
- Year 2: Community
  members pilot and assess
  the strategies identified in
  Year 1.
- Year 3: Community members refine and fully implement the successful strategies piloted in Year 2.

#### Program Staff

- Trainings provided by DYCD
- Ongoing professional development opportunities
- Reporting as required by DYCD

#### Outputs

- Number of community members engaged in the planning and implementation process
- Number of community members reached through planning and community engagement processes
- Strategies to address crime and safety are identified.
- Strategies are implemented.

#### **Outcomes**

- Community residents would increase skills, knowledge, and abilities to improve safety and crime conditions in the community.
- Safety assets and resources would be created in the NDA.
- Donated time, resources, or people to support implementation of strategies to address safety and crime conditions in the NDA would be increased

# Impact (CSBG National Goals)

Context and conditions: Eligible participants have incomes at or below 125 percent of the federal poverty level. Program areas and funding allocations are dictated by a Community Needs Assessment and engagement of the Neighborhood Advisory Boards. Eighty percent of participants must reside in the NDA.
