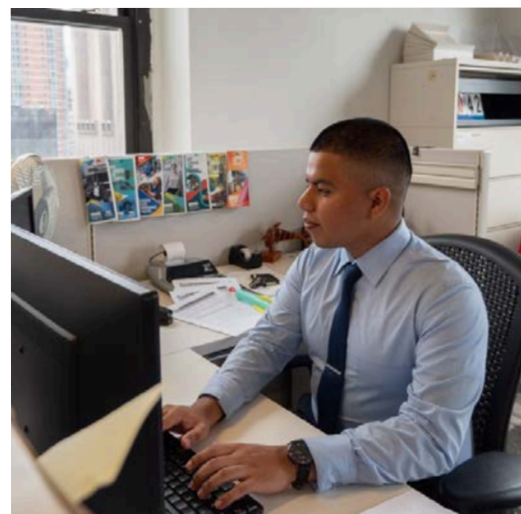

WHAT DOES IT LOOK LIKE TO HIRE NYC YOUTH?

As an employer, you'll work with DYCD and our network of community-based organizations (CBOs) to host youth in roles that match their age, skills, and interests.

- Youth ages 16-24
- Six-week job opportunities
- Up to 25 hours per week
- In-person, remote, or hybrid
- Rate of pay is \$17.00 per hour, paid by the City of New York
