What is the Work, Learn & Grow (WLG) Program?

WLG offers young people (between the ages of 16 and 20) from select NYC public schools an opportunity to strengthen work-readiness skills, explore careers, and receive academic support- including guidance on postsecondary education and the potential to earn a college credit.



What are the Eligibility Requirements?

You may qualify for **CareerReady WLG** if you are between the ages of 16 and 19 as of October 27, 2025, enrolled in a public high school, and were a participant of CareerReady SYEP 2025.

You may qualify for **Special Initiatives WLG** if you are between the ages of 16 and 20 as of October 27, 2025, are currently enrolled in an NYC public high school and were a participant of Special Initiatives SYEP 2025.

In addition to these requirements, all WLG participants must be a resident of one of the five boroughs of New York City and legally allowed to work in the US. *Ready to apply? Click here to get started.*

How Much Will I Be Paid?

WLG participants can earn up to \$4,213.50 throughout the program. Participants will be paid biweekly via direct deposit or a payroll debit card. Your Provider will explain the weekly hours breakdown of the program during orientation.
