

PA2: CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Traffic closures & detours

PA2: GREENWAY DETOUR | E 20TH – E 23RD ST

- East River Greenway Closure between
 E20th & E23rd Street February 15
- Bikeway detour, 24 hours/day, 7 days/week. Pedestrians to use local crosswalks and sidewalks.
- Detour is subject to change due to construction activities and upcoming Project Area 1 work
- Changes to detour will be communicated in advance of closures
- Future detours are actively being coordinated with DOT
- Avenue C Detour under FDR Drive from 18th to 20th Street is under ongoing coordination with DOT and the contractor







