East River Greenway Closure East 20th Street at FDR Dr. exit ramp to East 14th Street in East River Park

Starting the week of February 6, 2023 ongoing until further notice

The East River Greenway will be temporarily closed for construction activities from E 20th Street in Stuyvesant Cove Park at the FDR exit ramp to E 14th Street in East River Park. Current access to the Ferry will not be impacted. All cyclists should follow the Greenway detour below and posted signage.

The Greenway north of E 20th Street will remain open to the community. Access East River Park at the E 10th Street pedestrian bridge or the Houston Street overpass.
