

DDC | ESCR PA1 work near Montgomery St. & South St. to accommodate floodwall and floodgate construction

#### Floodwall Operations Resume at Montgomery Street and South Street

#### Beginning June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, Ongoing for about six months

Floodwall operations will resume at Montgomery Street and South Street, and will extend towards Water Street. This operation will necessitate a sidewalk closure along Montgomery St, between Water Street and South Street and a partial sidewalk closure on South Street at the corner of Montgomery St. (Building access will remain on South St.) Vehicle lane width reductions will occur on South St. and Montgomery Street. Please follow all signs and directions placed onsite to ensure safety.





- a. Vehicles: Parking Lane Along Montgomery and then one lane on South Street alternating left/right lane.
- **b. Pedestrians**: Sidewalks open for near term, however, will close as work continues.
- c. Work hours: Monday through Friday, from 8:00am-5:00 pm & Saturdays from 9:00am. to 5:00pm.
- d. Vibration settlement monitoring.
- e. Ongoing coordination as construction progresses.

### PA1 | Floodwall Work

WORK SUBJECT TO CHANGE

1

- DDC | ESCR PA1 work near Montgomery St. & South St. to accommodate floodwall and floodgate construction
  - **Clearing and grubbing.**
  - □ Set up MPT (lane closures) along Montgomery & South Steet to begin test pits.
  - **C** End of June to begin micropiles with full MPT (sidewalk closures).
  - □ Foundations for flood gates.
  - □ Construction of flood walls.

This work will continue into next year.






ESCR floodwall work

#### SIDEWALK CLOSURE AT MONTGOMERY ST. UNDER FDR DRIVE ONGOING UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

Construction activities will necessitate the closure of the sidewalk at Montgomery Street under FDR Drive (north side). This change will be in place 24 hours/day, 7 days/week. Traffic will be maintained and pedestrian detour is in effect. Please follow all signs and directions placed on-site to ensure safety.



- **3** DDC | ESCR PA1 Greenway floodwall activities from Montgomery St. to Cherry St.
  - a. work was originally scheduled as night work however the contractor has been able to perform most of this work during the day
  - b. floodwall activities will continue through Summer 2024








Micro-Piles for the Flood Wall Near Montgomery Street

WORK SUBJECT TO CHANGE

- 4 DDC | Water Street, Gouverneur Slip E., and South Street approximately 3-4 months and Jackson Street to follow.
- 1 Water Street work begins July 2, 2024 2 Gouverneur Slip E. 3 Jackson St. to follow
- Majority of work will be **Daytime: 7am 6pm.**
- Vehicles: Full roadway closure 24-hrs (No parking)
- Pedestrians: Majority of sidewalks will remain open. Some localized sidewalk closures will occur at Gouverneur's Slip E.
- **Deliveries:** Shall be from Jackson St. and Gouverneur Slip W. \*Special deliveries can be coordinated with CCL & Team.
- Ongoing coordination with emergency responders.
- Access-A-Ride: Should be notified to pick up residents on Jackson St. or in parking lot.







DDC | Water Street, Gouverneur Slip E., and South Street – approximately 3-4 months and Jackson Street to follow.

#### **TYPICAL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES FOR ALL 3 STREETS:**

- a. MPT (maintenance and protection of traffic and pedestrians). July for Water St.
- b. Utility relocation work. (excavate, relocate if necessary and then install new facilities in same trench) July for Water St.
- c. Installation of PC Sewer.
- d. After Water St., repeat same steps for Gouverneur Slip E operation scheduled for 3-4 months.
- e. South St. Restoration & Jackson St. to follow






