


Overview of Contracts

will help protect the community from floods that result from heavy rainfall during storm events




WATERFRONT FLOOD PROTECTION

ESCR PA1 | East River Park Status


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Phase 1 amenities opened in September 2025

➔ Park access via Corlears Hook Bridge and Pier 42
(and Delancey Street Bridge)

Ongoing and future work in southern portion of East River Park

- 1 Former shared use path along FDR Drive to remain a construction road through the end of project
- 2 Ecology Center (compost yard and educational building) to be built south of Amphitheater
 - Design team presenting at CB3 Parks Committee on Thursday 2/12: <https://on.nyc.gov/49ZL2V2>
- 3 Temporary closure of Amphitheater will be required at later date to install canopy
- 4 Temporary closure of Corlears Hook Bridge will be required at later date to install permanent fencing



ESCR PA1 | Montgomery St. and South St.

ALL WORK IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE

Completed PA1 Work:

- Installation of floodwall at Montgomery St. and South St. intersection
- Installation of floodgates crossing roadway on either side of the FDR Drive

Now:

- GG capital façade work is ongoing
 - DDC expects to regain access in Summer 2026

Next Steps:


- When façade work is complete, DDC/ESCR will return to the area for final restoration, including:
 - Grading and installation of horticultural soil
 - Installation of fencing
 - Installation of landscaping (schedule determined by planting season)

ESCR Parallel Conveyance (PC)

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


ESCR PC | Work in Vicinity of Gouverneur Gardens

ALL WORK IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE

Final restoration of South Street and most of Water Street is complete

- Permanent street light on Water Street anticipated to be installed later this month
- Two trees to be planted by NYC Parks on sidewalk of Water Street



ESCR PC | Work in Vicinity of Gouverneur Gardens


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Restoration at intersection of Water & Jackson St.

- Expected to be completed at same time as final restoration of Jackson Street (**anticipated Summer 2026**)
- Any traffic/parking impacts will be communicated in advance and coordinated with emergency services
- Restoration work is always weather-dependent (typically only feasible in spring and summer months)


Corlears Hook Park

- Sewer work **anticipated to begin May 2026**
- Playground construction **anticipated to begin Summer 2026**
- Redesign of former site of Interceptor Gate Building is ongoing
- Final restoration of Corlears Hook Park field and playground **anticipated later this year**

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


BMCR | Work in Vicinity of Gouverneur Gardens

ALL WORK IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE

Remaining Work:

- Floodgates anticipated to be installed this summer.
- Trunk main installation to follow, including necessary utility relocation.
- Restoration to be completed at the end of project.
- Intermittent road closures and traffic disruptions will be required, but traffic will be maintained with flaggers and signage.
