
The East Side Coastal Resiliency (ESCR) Project is an initiative to provide long-term flood protection on the east side of Manhattan.

Nightwork and Traffic Detour resume along West Service Rd. between E 23rd & E 25th Streets Mon-Fri, 10:00 pm to 5:00 am

Floodwall construction operations necessitate vehicular traffic detour resuming September 13, 2021, ongoing until further notice.

Vehicles & pedestrians to follow all posted signs and instructions from Traffic Enforcement Agents & Flaggers while detour is in effect. Night work will alternate in areas identified below.
