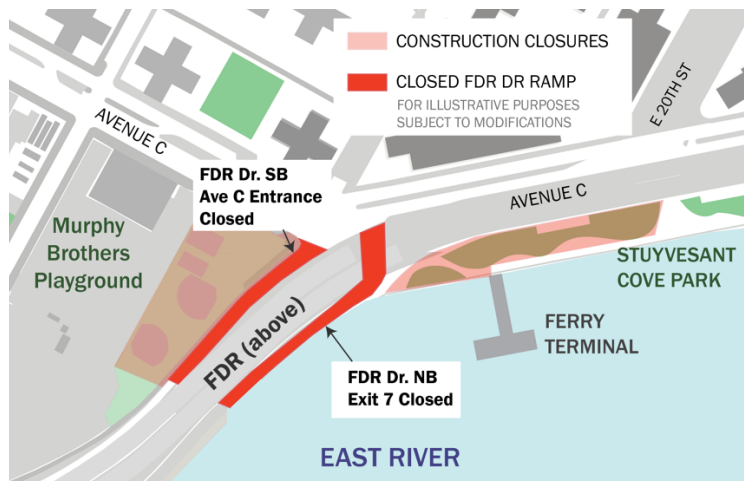
The East Side Coastal Resiliency (ESCR) Project is an initiative to provide long-term flood protection on the east side of Manhattan.

## Nightwork: FDR Drive Exit 7 and Ave C Entrance Closure From Friday, July 28<sup>th</sup>, 10:00 pm to Saturday, July 29<sup>th</sup>, 5:00 am

Construction activities will necessitate the closure of the FDR Drive northbound Exit 7 (E 20 - E 23 St) exit ramp and southbound Avenue C on-ramp. Traffic on FDR Drive will be maintained.

Please use the following alternative exits/entrances:

- Northbound exit please use Exit 5 (E Houston St Williamsburg Br) or Exit 8 (E 34 St Midtown Tun)
- Southbound entrance please use Entrance 7 (E 20 - E 23 St) or Entrance 5 (E Houston St Williamsburg Br)
