Nightwork under FDR Drive from Gouverneur Slip West to Jackson Street


Beginning September 3, 2024

Floodwall operations under the FDR Drive will require overnight work hours. Vehicle lane width reductions will continue on South Street and Montgomery Street. A closure of up to two northbound lanes of the FDR Drive will occur overnight. Please follow all signs and on-site directions to ensure safety.
