

## Nightwork and Traffic Detours at FDR Drive Northbound Exit 7 and Southbound On-Ramp at Avenue C and E. 18<sup>th</sup> Street Friday, October 11, 2024 at 10:00 pm to Saturday, October 12, 2024 at 5:00 am

This overnight operation facilitates the testing of Floodgates 9 and 11 at E. 18<sup>th</sup> Street and FDR Drive. <u>For northbound Exit 7</u>, please use Exit 5 (E. Houston St. / Williamsburg Br.) or Exit 8 (E. 34<sup>th</sup> St. / Midtown Tun.). <u>For southbound access</u> to FDR Drive, please use the E. 30<sup>th</sup> Street or E. Houston Street on-ramps. Traffic on FDR Drive will be maintained at all times.
